


‘Healing Within Your Family’ Inner Healing and Deliverance Prayers

*The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord
is upon me, for the Lord has
anointed me to bring good news
to the poor.*



*He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to the captives,
And the opening of the prison
to those who are bound - Isaiah 61:1*

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*******Most of the prayers in this PDF are unique and not a replica of other people's ideas ~ they are created through revelation of the Holy Spirit and our view of what He has shown us as He works with us. There may be the odd prayer or idea that has been added to our Ministry from others because it impacted us, but more often than not you will be viewing an original.***

All prayers are subject to change as God gives new insight and revelation. All prayers are to be prayed out loud. Often you will see we ask you to do a prophetic act. A prophetic act is an action of obedience as a step of faith in the natural (physical) realm that supports God's workings in the spiritual realm, to release the power, presence and victory of God into a situation.

Prayer of Protection: “Father God in the name of Jesus Christ and by the Power of Your Holy Spirit I pray that You would guide me through this journey of deliverance and healing. I thank You for the presence of the Holy Spirit.

I ask for Your protection, and that I am covered with the Blood of Jesus Christ. I also pray this protection over my loved ones, our pets, our belongings and our surroundings.

With the authority given to me by the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I bind you Satan, all demons and any other agents of Satan, my own human flesh which is antichrist, from any harm or attacks targeting me, my family, our homes and properties, our pets and belongings, our health and our finances, our businesses and our ministries.

I also bind you from any interference, distraction, transference, or blocking or counterfeiting the Holy Spirit, in Jesus name. I bind up and forbid any counterfeit gifts, un-godly manifestations, and lying signs and wonders, in Jesus name.

Father God, I thank You for Your heavenly angels and pray that they would be released in accordance with Your word.”

Please Note - Many of our prayers as an added precaution will include the term ‘ancestors’ to cover any sins that they may have participated in that you are unaware of.

Husband and Wife Prayer - The Lord has revealed to us that demons can have access to us because of the incorrect dynamic between husband and wife. The correct order/dynamic is when the husband and wife respect, love and honour one another as equals, and when the wife allows the husband to protect her as the weaker vessel. The Word of God tells us that man and woman are equal; they are both created in the image of God. ***So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them (Genesis 1:27, NKJV).*** The Bible tells us that man and woman when joined become one flesh, not two separate entities, so not one is greater than the other. ***Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh (Genesis 2:24, NKJV).*** In the Garden of Eden Eve ate the forbidden fruit, and then coerced Adam to do the same. This act created a curse to come upon man and woman. ***To the woman He said: “I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you shall bring forth children; your desire shall be for your husband, and he shall rule over you” (Genesis 3:16, NKJV).*** This poses a problem. Men and woman are **cursed for man to rule over the woman**. The Jezebel spirit coerced woman to rise up in disobedience, to proclaim back equality, so in turn tried to rule over the husband. Disunity, chaos, bickering, and contention was borne. Having no respect in the home between mum and dad can enable children to learn from their parent’s example, in turn resulting in dishonour towards mum and dad. This in turn brings rebellion into the mix. The following scripture spoken by Paul has been misused by many as a means for the husband to continue to dominate the wife. ***Submission to Husbands: Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear. Do not let your***

adornment be merely outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel— rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God. For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good and are not afraid with any terror. A Word to Husbands: Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honour to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered (1 Peter 3: 1-7, NKJV).

The word submit (**Hupotasso** in Greek) means 'be subject to', to get under and lift up, to put in order, to subject one's self, obey, to submit to one's control, to yield to one's admonition or advice. **Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church: For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church. Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. (Ephesians 5:21-33, KJV).** By this Scripture we see that husbands and wives are to submit to one another. Submit is better translated as 'identifying with' and 'supporting one another' in our God given roles as well as humbling ourselves and exalting one another. Husbands are not to rule over the wife, nor take power over her, as this is part of the curse that Christ came to break off believers.

The relationship between husband and wife is about honouring and respecting each other's roles in the house and marriage. The wife is made as the weaker vessel and needs to allow the husband to protect and care for her and the family. He is her covering. He is the head of her and the family in the sense that He is responsible for the provision and well-being of His family. **But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever (1 Timothy 5:8, NKJV).** The wife needs to honour and support him in this role of leadership. Many argue that because woman is made from man, he has dominance over her. This is incorrect. **For as woman came from man, even so man also comes through woman; but all things are from God (1 Corinthians 11:12, NKJV).** This Scripture shows equality as the woman also gives birth to the man. Another scripture used for men to rule over the wife is: **The head over every man is Christ, the head over woman is man and the head over Christ is God (1 Corinthians 11:3, NKJV).** God's order is that the husband is the head of

the wife as God is the head of Christ. The word **Head** when taken back to the Greek means superiority. How is man superior to the woman when they are created equal, and how is God superior when God and Jesus are one and created equal? ***For when I am weak, then I am strong (2 Corinthians 12:10, NKJV)***. The husband is physically stronger so protects the weaker vessel in the physical. Jesus also had weakness in His flesh as He humbled himself and became a man. ***For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted (Luke 14:11, NKJV)***. He came in humility as a servant, to serve, but there is no inequality or inferiority between them.

Please note the following Scripture: ***Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name (Philippians 2:5-9, NKJV)***. Jesus was equal with God as He is God, but made Himself lower by becoming a man in a servant role. God then exalted Him above all things. ***Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father (Philippians 2:9 – 11, KJV)***.

You have heard Me say to you, 'I am going away and coming back to you.' If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, 'I am going to the Father,' for My Father is greater than I' (John 14:28, NKJV). We know by Scripture that God and Jesus are equal but in **John** Jesus is saying that God the Father is greater than He. God and Christ are equal and united, just as the husband and the wife are one. The kingdom is about humility and becoming as servants. In the humbling of oneself one to the other we are exalted. I believe also to have Christ as head over us, it implies a protective covering. Christ is our covering. The husband protects the wife and the family, as Christ protects them both. How can Christ protect a family when there is no unity between husband and wife? ***Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken (Ecclesiastes 4:12, NKJV)***.

God revealed to Mark and I that I did not submit to Mark as head over me because I did not trust him to keep our children safe from the dangers of the world. I came from a background of hurt, rejection and sexual abuse. I was over-protective toward the children. I smothered them and struggled to let them be 'kids'. Mark was the complete opposite. He came from a family of praying Christians and was not subjected to a world like me. It was as though he couldn't see danger in anything which in turn caused me to take on the role of double-protector. God told us that He was going to remove the burden of being sole-protector from me and in turn pass a bit of what I had to Mark to bring about a healthy balance. I had to forgive Mark for not protecting the children (to my standards) and he in turn had to forgive me for not seeing him as our protector because of my idiosyncrasies. He told us to lay ourselves and everything

that makes us tick as the foot of the cross. There were many other things that Mark and I did that were in complete opposition to one another which caused many a conflict.

I was over-sensitive, Mark was mostly insensitive. I was emotional, Mark was emotionless. I was a big softie to the children in comparison to Mark who was very strict. Husband and Wife become one flesh when they marry. Unity is what God intended. God showed us that He was going to give us unity and an understanding of one another by removing, changing, re-jigging and exchanging those things within us as a couple that were not yet perfected by Him which caused disunity. He was going to issue back what He wanted us to have with divine balance! Husbands and wives also need to lay down their flesh and their drives and see each other as more important, just as Christ laid down his life for His bride. Husbands and wives also need to give authority of their own bodies over to one another. ***The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does (1 Corinthians 7:4, NKJV).***

Prayer for Husband: (Husband) - "Dear God, in the name of Jesus Christ I repent on behalf of myself and ancestors for the incorrect order between husband and wife. I repent that I haven't humbled myself and exalted my wife. I repent on behalf of Adam who allowed himself to be tempted by Eve to eat of the forbidden fruit. I repent for myself and every man in my bloodline who ruled over woman believing themselves to be greater. I repent also for not protecting woman as the weaker vessel, instead abusing and treating them with dishonour, contempt and lack of respect. I repent also for myself and all men in my bloodline for allowing woman to dominate and disrespect us. I lay down to You Lord Jesus my need to control. I lay all fleshly needs, desires and drives at the foot of the cross. I repent for putting these desires ahead of my wife. I ask You to help me see my wife as more important than my fleshly needs. I ask you (*wife's name*) on behalf of yourself and all the women in your bloodline to forgive me on behalf of myself and all men for hatred and dishonour toward women. I ask forgiveness for also not protecting you and the children as the weaker vessel and for not fulfilling my duties as head of the house".

(Wife) – "I forgive you".

(Husband) - (*Take wife's hand and say*) - "I honour you, cherish you, protect you and affirm you as my wife. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and ask God to bless you".

Prayer for Wife: (Wife) - "Dear God, in the name of Jesus Christ I repent on behalf of myself and ancestors for the incorrect order of husband and wife. I repent that I haven't humbled myself and exalted my husband. I repent on behalf of Eve who ate of the forbidden fruit in the Garden of Eden, then tempted Adam to do the same. I repent for all the woman in my bloodline, including myself for allowing ourselves to be dominated, disrespected and abused by men. I repent also for myself and all woman in my bloodline who tried to dominate and rule over men, as well as refusing to be seen as the weaker vessel and not allowing man to protect us and our children. I repent for worshipping the Jezebel movement. I repent for dishonour, abuse and lack of respect shown to men. I lay down to You Lord Jesus my need to control. I lay all fleshly needs, desires and drives at the foot of the cross. I repent for putting these

desires ahead of my husband. I ask You to help me see my husband as more important than my fleshly needs. I ask you (*husband's name*) on behalf of yourself and all the men in your bloodline to forgive me on behalf of myself and all women for hatred and dishonour towards men. I ask forgiveness for not respecting you as you should have been”.

(Husband) – “I forgive you”.

(Wife) -“I submit to you and acknowledge your protection, love and support as head over me and our family. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and I ask God to bless you”.

(Husband and wife) - "We forgive Adam and Eve for the curse of man ruling over woman. We break this curse in Jesus name and declare that we are equal. We are both created in the image of Father God. Help us Lord Jesus to always show love, honour and respect to one another. We now hand the reins over to you Lord Jesus as head over us and our family. We lay at the foot of the cross 'ourselves' and everything else that makes us tick. We ask that You give back to us a divine balance so that we can operate in unity as one flesh and as You intended. We ask that You bless this Holy union in Jesus name – Amen”. *If husband and wife still find they cannot agree on certain things, then submit it to the Lord and ask Him to show you the correct way!*

Binding couples together - This is a powerful prayer binding a couple together. You will need to get someone else to pray it over you.

(PRAY) - “In the name of Jesus Christ I want to tie a bond between you – linking you spiritually – this bond will withstand and not break easily.

(A prophetic act) – “I bind you both together with spiritual ropes – ropes of love, unity, peace and understanding. I break the chains of division and separation – arguments, strife, anger and lies. I release love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. I impart an impenetrable love between you both that is like a fortress that cannot be touched by the evil one. No arrow, no dart, no devil, person, or demon will ever divide, conquer or make this wall of love fall. **A threefold cord is not easily broken (Ecclesiastes 4:12, KJV).**

Parents and Children - Once dissension has entered a home where husband and wife are in disunity it can bring in the spirit of rebellion, rejection and self-rejection, especially into the children. These spirits can invade the children when they do not meet parent’s expectations. They see discipline as rejection, and in turn may end up rejecting themselves – in the belief that they are not good enough. Parents will need to ask their children for forgiveness for the expectations they have put upon them, especially when they were upset with them for not meeting their expectations. Parents also will need to forgive their children for not meeting their expectations. The children will need to forgive themselves for not measuring up, especially if they condemned themselves for not being perfect, and forgive their parents for the expectations. The children will also need to repent for dishonour towards mum and dad. **Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honour your father and mother,”**

which is the first commandment with promise: “that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth” (Ephesians 6:1-3, NKJV). Parents will need to repent to God for the incorrect dynamic between them, which gave the children incorrect teachings on respect and honour. If bickering between siblings is present they will need to say sorry to one another and ask each other for forgiveness.

For a very long time we struggled with our youngest son Brayden. His behaviour was full of anger, tantrums, rebellion and discord. He rejected himself terribly. My husband and I loved him deeply and we couldn't understand why he always felt so rejected. There were many times when he told us he hated us, that we didn't love him and that he wanted a new family. This behaviour was aimed predominantly against me. God, after some time revealed the root of this rejection. There was a wall of separation between me and my son which wouldn't allow him to receive my love. No matter how much love I put into him, it bounced right off and he couldn't receive it. I loved him dearly and had no idea that my love wasn't reaching him. Satan had a legal right and used it. My own father never properly affirmed me as I grew up. I knew he loved me as he always showed me lots of love but I don't recall him ever telling me he was proud of me. I always felt that I was never good enough and could never gain his approval or measure up to his standards. When I was young he and my brother had a very close bond. They would play sport all the time together and me being the girl I seemed to always be in the way of them and left out. If I ever tried to do all things they could do, I would only end up failing with them laughing at me which made me feel even worse of a failure. A lot of my young childhood life I always found myself feeling left out - there was always someone who out shone me. The spirit of abandonment within me grew stronger when my father and my mother divorced when I was ten leaving my father finding himself a new home. I still saw my dad but it was never the same as when he was living with us. After a while he remarried and had three more sons.

I have also suffered various forms of sexual abuse in my younger years from different guys, which gave me a view of love and men. I got terribly bullied and picked on predominantly by boys at school and college when I was growing up. The men in my family were into pornography, as well as every boyfriend I went out with.

It distorted my view of men and I believed that all men only saw woman in a perverted fashion. I came to the conclusion that all men were perverted and were only after one thing. It made me sick and I developed a bitter hatred towards men. Throughout my teenage and young adult years I sought love in all the wrong places. I became sexually promiscuous to fill that love deficit and deep feelings of rejection. I wanted to be accepted and I went the wrong way about it. I didn't know real love until I met Father God. For the first few years of my walk with God He showed me that I rejected His love. I had built a wall around my heart and I found it incredibly difficult to trust God. You see I saw God as a man, which distorted my view of Him, until one day God finally broke down that wall and I actually saw Him as my dad. I remember the day as I cried out to Him and called Him dad for the first time, and actually meant it. I told Him I loved him over and over, and that I finally trusted Him. I had a vision of Him with His arms around me, and I remember getting incredibly warm from His presence as I received a fresh infilling of God's pure love. God showed me that at that moment I got

delivered from the orphan spirit, the spirit of slavery who separates us from the love of God.

God told me that the many infirmities I had been suffering were a direct result of lack of self-worth. Until I knew who I was in Christ I could not receive healing. I finally knew now who I was. A daughter, a beloved daughter who was loved unconditionally. After I received this infilling the Lord showed me that my son hadn't been able to receive my love because of that judgment against men that I had created. It had become a bitter root judgment and I was reaping what I had sown. When I openly declared I hated men, it gave satan a legal right to put a dividing wall between my son and me. My son was male, so it applied to him. Satan is a sneaky snake. I explained this to my son as best as I could and asked him to forgive me. I repented to God for the judgment I had made against all men. I asked my son to forgive me for the expectations that I had put on him. He did, and then forgave himself for believing he was no good and unworthy each time he couldn't meet them. I forgave him for not measuring up to my expectations and we blessed each other. My son and I wept as we affirmed each other and he finally received my love. The love of his mother that he had been lacking for so long. He is my son, and I am his mum. The result from this was immediate. You could literally see the difference when the love that I had felt for him all these years was finally imparted.

Added note: - During Ministry one session I came across a lady who had been hated by her mother. The main reason for this was that her mother had hated her husband and the daughter reminded her of him. The Lord said to me that many people judge the children for the sins of the forefathers (which is male and female ancestors). I have added this to the prayer below.

Prayer for Parents and Children -

(Parents) - *(One at a time)* "Dear God in Jesus name I repent for myself and bloodline for judging the children for the sins of the forefathers. I repent for teaching our children the incorrect order between husband and wife. Help us to be good role models to our children, teaching them about love, respect and honouring one another. I repent for putting expectations on my kids which made them feel rejected when they didn't meet them, and for holding unforgiveness when they didn't meet my expectations. I repent also for the times I have provoked my children to wrath. *(Address each child individually)* Will you forgive me for judging you and putting expectations on you that made you feel unworthy and rejected when you didn't measure up to my expectations"?

(Child) - "Yes, and I forgive myself for not meeting your expectations. Dear God I repent for being rebellious and dishonouring my mum and dad. Mum and dad will you forgive me for not meeting your expectations, being rebellious and dishonouring you"?

(Parents) - "Yes"

Bless and affirm each other individually (We have made blessing and affirming each other a daily practice).

Marriage troubles - The team and I were once ministering to a lady who was married and the marriage was breaking down. Her husband and she were still together but it was a struggle and both parties had also committed adultery against each other. During this session the Lord spoke to me about marriage and this is what He spoke: - ***Sanctity - The state of being holy, sacred or saintly. The sanctity of marriage Hebrews 13:4, NKJV Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge. My children today do not honour their marriage vows. These vows are taken in front of witnesses and before God. Too many of My children are marrying before seeking God. I have a person selected for those whom are meant to marry. If one chooses a partner different to the one whom I have chosen then that marriage can and will be blessed but the obstacles will be greater. If one marries the one God has selected them that marriage will bear much fruit. Repentance for marrying one other than God intended will need to be done. Will that marriage work? Of course. God can pour His blessings and favour on any marriage. All mistakes can become used for good. Why then can sometimes the marriage God has chosen still be so hard? Curses and warring in your bloodlines to oppose this marriage. If God-given marriages bear much fruit then why isn't this one? Unbelief that this marriage is sanctified and chosen by God.*** The couple in question did not believe that God had ordained and sanctioned this marriage. He then said ***"You need to make a recommitment to one another. Rededicate yourselves a fresh to one another. Keep your vows and commitments. Honour your marriage and honour your vows and God will honour you. Repent to me and to each other for breaking the commitment you made to each other. Forgive each other and start afresh. I will bless you, I will bless your marriage. Trust in Me to do this. Ask Me to put the fear of God in you in regard to your marriage vows and commitment. The fear of God is reverence and adoration for your creator and the ability to want to honour Him and His name. The power of agreement when two parties agree and remain steadfast can't be broken."***

Husband and Wife – “Father God we repent for breaking our marriage vows, covenants and commitments we made before You, before witnesses and each other. We repent if we married anyone other than who You selected for us. If our marriage and partnership was ordained by You and we never believed it we repent. We ask that You would put the fear of God into us both so that our commitment and vows to one another impact and reflect our adoration and reverence to You as our creator. We ask You to do this so our decision to make choices honour our commitment not only to each other but to You also. We believe that You will honour this marriage and will bless this Holy union.

Husband: - “I am sorry (*Wife's name*) for breaking the vows, covenants and commitments I made to You. Will you forgive me?”

Wife: - “Yes I forgive you for any wrongs you have committed and I let go of them and hand over to God any past hurts and unresolved anger I’ve carried so that our relationship can move forward with renewed grace and healing”.

Husband: - “I rededicate and recommitment myself afresh to you today before God. I commit to creating new memories together that will be filled with joy and laughter. I resolve to build my life with you on a firm foundation of faith in God and His word. I honour you, cherish you, protect you and affirm you as my wife. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and ask God to bless you”.

Wife: - “I am sorry (*Husband’s name*) for breaking the vows, covenants and commitments I made to You. Will you forgive me?”

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Wife: - I rededicate and recommitment myself afresh to you today before God. I commit to creating new memories together that will be filled with joy and laughter. I resolve to build my life with you on a firm foundation of faith in God and His word. I honour you, cherish you, support you and affirm you as my husband. I submit to your headship as authority and protection over me. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and ask God to bless you”.

Ask God to show you if there are any curses or anything else hindering your marriage then deal with what He shows you.

Unconditional Love – Unconditional love is continuing to love no matter what. God gives parents unconditional love for their children. The opposite of love is hate. When we hate we are not entering into unconditional love. God as a parent pours unconditional love on us as His children. God could never and would never hate us. He is our creator and the father of our spirits and He loves us all the time. He loves us every day no matter what we do. He loves us even whilst we are sinners. This of course is why He came in the form of a man (Jesus) and died on a cross for us. He loves us so much that He wants us all to be saved. Father God promises that nothing can separate us from His love. ***Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: “For Your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.” Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:35-39, NKJV).***

Why then do we sometimes not receive more of His love when we ask for it? Sin! Sin blocks us receiving it from Him. He is giving His love all the time but sometimes we cannot receive it. Sin in our lives creates a blockage, just like unbelief prevented many

miracles of Jesus. ***There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love (1 John 4:18, NKJV).*** By this Scripture we see that perfect loves casts out fear. If we still fear then we haven't received the fullness of Gods perfect love. I sought more of His love as fear was huge in my life. Unable to receive it God revealed yet another blockage as to why I wasn't receiving more of His perfect love.

My story begins with the time I was saved. A few weeks after I was saved my testimony brought many to the Lord. My two children Annahlise (who was 7) and my son Brayden (4) wanted to know what was going on with their mother. After explaining as best as I could to the children what had happened to me they decided they wanted to say sorry to God for their sins and ask Jesus into their hearts. My daughter was born-again and baptised in the spirit immediately and started crying and laughing and singing for nearly half the day. It was such a sight. Not much happened to my son at this time but we assumed that he too must have been born again and baptised. Not so - from that day began a myriad of bad behaviour from my son. He reduced me to tears many times. It appeared that satan was using him to create chaos, stress and tension within the house. This went on for many years when the Lord revealed to me that my son hadn't been able to receive my love and why (See Parents and Children Prayer). After this revelation things got better for a while but then escalated out of control again. The Holy Spirit revealed to me some time later that my son was actually not yet born again and filled with the spirit like we had thought. When I asked why all He told me was that something was being outworked in me. That was almost two years ago. We worried for my son in this time believing that without God in his life he might walk down a destructive path. We wondered too how long it would take before He would be filled with the Holy Spirit.

My son's birthday is in June and he was coming up for his 11th birthday in 2016 when I really had gotten to my wits end with his behaviour and attitude. We had teachers and the deputy principal ringing us on numerous occasions because of his behaviour. The day of his 11th birthday the Holy Spirit said to me "I have a word for you". I sat down with pen and paper to receive the word and what He spoke to me was amazing. I have written it word for word how it came. ***"Brayden is still not yet born-again into my Kingdom but he soon will be. I know his desire and he wants Me. He is mine and I am his. There is a timing involved and it is because of you that I waited. I sent Brayden to you to outwork something in you - unconditional love no matter what. My daughter well done you still love him no matter what he does. This is the same for me and my children. I want to save them all because I am their father. There is a sin in your bloodline – 'Lack of unconditional love'. Parents in your bloodline hated their children, they murdered their children and sacrificed them to many gods. You my daughter were judged guilty of their sin even though you had not committed the sin.*** (I had inherited this iniquity before I became a Christian because of the Generational Curse line). ***My Word says to work through your salvation with fear and trembling. This was a sin that needed to be outworked. True repentance is when one turns away from sin and does not continue in that sin.***" Right at that moment I knew that I had been going through this outworking because every time my son got me to a place of such anger I heard my own voice in my head screaming 'I hate you'. Hate is as murder. The enemy wanted me to scream

those words to my son. If I had then I would have continued in that sin 'Lack of Unconditional Love'. I resisted that voice every time and never once said those words to my son out loud although I came close many times. Whilst my head was screaming I hate you I would say to him, "No matter what you do and no matter how you treat me I will always love you." After I spoke this I always knew I meant it. God told me that Satan had come to him and petitioned this sin against me. Satan didn't want me to receive God's perfect love that casts out fear. God had made a deal with him and that deal was 'If I could still love my son after a period of time and never tell him I hated him then God would remove the sins of the fathers from me and I could receive His Perfect love'. God told me that I passed the test and that night He would infill my son with the Holy Spirit if he asked Him to. My son came home from school and I told him what God had told me. I told him when he was ready and if he wanted to he could go and seek God by himself and say sorry for his sins and ask Jesus into his heart. That night my son shut himself away in his room and coming through the door we heard loud laughing then loud sobbing. This went on for over ten minutes when he came out and said "I received God". I asked for God to also fill my son with the Gift of Tongues in the name of Jesus Christ. He started trying to pray in tongues immediately. My daughter had never properly prayed in tongues either so she asked for the same gift. It happened for her immediately. More tears and laughing.

Interestingly not long after this I became aware that my son reverted back to his old ways and soon forgot about what had happened. He started becoming more and more rebellious. Things became so strained between us but still I never uttered those words that the devil wanted me to toward my son. The Lord told me that my son had been asking the devil to show himself as he had convinced himself that neither the devil nor God was real. As he was nearing his 18th birthday, he was heading down a path of great destruction. I remember one day on my knees crying out to God to give my son an encounter where he could not deny God's presence. Brayden had made it clear that he didn't believe in God anymore and put his 'God moments' down to hype and told us he no longer would follow God unless he got an encounter for himself. He told us that he had asked God multiple times to show him he was real. He told us that he had given God a promise and that promise was 'if God revealed Himself to him in a way that he could no longer deny his presence then he would lay down his life and follow him and do whatever he asked of him'.

On Mother's Day 2022 Brayden told us that he had a massive encounter with God that night. He said that he was lying in bed wondering about life and how he existed and what it was like before he was born when all of a sudden he had an out of body experience and knew that he was in the place of not existing before he was born. He said that he was in darkness when He felt the love of God and was weeping and God talked to Him in a heavenly language and told him that he was chosen for a purpose and that he needed to know right from wrong and needed to follow the Bible and become more like Christ. He then told us that he wanted to dedicate his life to following Jesus and that he was going to quit the worldly antics and that he now believes in God 100% and will never doubt His existence ever again. The Lord revealed to me that in that time he had delivered him from a spirit of rebellion.

Today as I write this (October 2022) Brayden has decided to become a pastor and is going to start his three year degree next year in our local Church. Isn't God good!

(PRAYER FOR BREAKING OFF 'LACK OF UNCONDITIONAL LOVE') – “Father God I repent that I believed the lie that you do not love me unconditionally. I repent that I believed you couldn't or didn't love me because of the things I do wrong. I declare that nothing can separate me from the love of God. The opposite of love is hate and Father God you could never hate me. Father God you give me unconditional love even though I do not deserve it. Unconditional love is love from a parent to a child and it is God-given. Thank you that You gave me this love for my children even when they do not deserve it. I repent for my family bloodline for every person who did not give unconditional love to their children. I repent for the beatings, the hatred, the hurt and the murder towards the children. I am so sorry for the hatred the parents in my bloodline had for their children. Your gift of unconditional love was rejected and I repent for this. Father God I forgive every parent in my bloodline for 'lack of unconditional love' to their children. I pray now Father that in Jesus name You would fill me and my children to overflowing with your perfect unconditional love, Amen.”

Post Deliverance Infilling Prayer - “I break every curse over my life from preconception to the present day in the name of Jesus Christ. I ask Father God that every curse would be replaced with a blessing. In the name of Jesus and by the stripes He bore on His body I pray for healing within every area of my spirit/soul and body. (*Pray specifically for all ailments*). I command all misalignments to come into divine order in Jesus name. I cast out the spirit of infirmity in Jesus name. I cast out fear, shock and trauma in Jesus name. I command every fibre, every cell and every part of this body to come into divine order. I command all pain to leave in Jesus name. I pray for a creative miracle in all areas where body matter needs to be regenerated. I command all cells, cell structure, DNA, RNA, and all parts of the spirit/soul and body not to remember all traumas in Jesus name. I pray for the fire of God to burn off all remaining remnants and dross in Jesus name. I command every demon who has access to me to leave immediately in Jesus name. With the blood of the lamb I seal all doorways closed to the demonic and declare that demons can only exit and not re-enter. I bind the demonic doorkeepers and terminate their assignment against me in Jesus name. I ask for the Holy Spirit to infill with light all areas that were once dark in Jesus name. I pray for a hedge of protection to be placed around me and for any holes to be repaired in Jesus name. Thank You Father God in Jesus name for delivering me”.
