


‘I Surrender’

Inner Healing and Deliverance Prayers

*The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord
is upon me, for the Lord has
anointed me to bring good news
to the poor.*



*He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to the captives,
And the opening of the prison
to those who are bound - Isaiah 61:1*

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*******Most of the prayers in this PDF are unique and not a replica of other people's ideas ~ they are created through revelation of the Holy Spirit and our view of what He has shown us as He works with us. There may be the odd prayer or idea that has been added to our Ministry from others because it impacted us, but more often than not you will be viewing an original.***

All prayers are subject to change as God gives new insight and revelation. All prayers are to be prayed out loud. Often you will see we ask you to do a prophetic act. A prophetic act is an action of obedience as a step of faith in the natural (physical) realm that supports God's workings in the spiritual realm, to release the power, presence and victory of God into a situation.

Prayer of Protection: “Father God in the name of Jesus Christ and by the Power of Your Holy Spirit I pray that You would guide me through this journey of deliverance and healing. I thank You for the presence of the Holy Spirit.

I ask for Your protection, and that I am covered with the Blood of Jesus Christ. I also pray this protection over my loved ones, our pets, our belongings and our surroundings.

With the authority given to me by the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I bind you Satan, all demons and any other agents of Satan, my own human flesh which is antichrist, from any harm or attacks targeting me, my family, our homes and properties, our pets and belongings, our health and our finances, our businesses and our ministries.

I also bind you from any interference, distraction, transference, or blocking or counterfeiting the Holy Spirit, in Jesus name. I bind up and forbid any counterfeit gifts, un-godly manifestations, and lying signs and wonders, in Jesus name.

Father God, I thank You for Your heavenly angels and pray that they would be released in accordance with Your word.”

Please Note - Many of our prayers as an added precaution will include the term ‘ancestors’ to cover any sins that they may have participated in that you are unaware of.

Are you a Disciple? - One night I was worshipping the Lord when I sensed He wanted to speak to me. I sat down in my room armed with pen and paper and wrote what I heard. After receiving this word it didn’t sit right in my spirit so I went to Scripture to discern if the voice speaking to me was the Lord Jesus or an imposter. The problem was that there were Scriptures that appeared to back it up, and Scriptures that could also make the word deception. However at the end of my searching I deemed it to be deception. Below is the word and how I determined it to be deception, and the extra revelations that unfolded as I typed this article and prayer.

Word: - ***“Are you ready for the second infilling? All you had to do was never leave Me. Never leaving Me is never giving up hope in Me. The second infilling is coming to those who have been through the fiery furnace and come out ready. For many are called but few are chosen. The chosen ones are My disciples. Are all My children disciples? What is a disciple? One who has been trained by Me. Not all of My children are disciplined by Me. The ones I have chosen to carry more of My anointing are disciplined by Me. There are varying levels of My anointing. The higher the anointing the greater the discipling. You are disciplined by Me. There are many who follow Me but only a select few are disciplined by Me. These are the ones who are destined to carry My Glory. They are forerunners who carry My Glory before I return. My Glory is about to be unleashed on those.”***

This word was saying that only the ones chosen to carry more of His anointing could be called disciples. What then could other followers of Christ be called? A Christian? Is a Disciple greater than a Christian? What does Scripture say about chosen ones?

“For many are called, but few are chosen.” (Matthew 22:14, NKJV). While the parable of this passage refers to salvation, the Lord showed me that the principle also applies to our calling to Christian service. All Christians are called by God to His

service for different callings and positions. No position or calling is greater or more important than another but some people are **chosen** to carry a greater anointing and responsibility than others for their specific position in Christ. This is one example of 'For many are called but few are chosen'. Another example is, sometimes before you can be strategically placed into the position where God wants you, there is usually a time of testing before he/she is actually appointed to that service. The testing a Christian must pass is usually more intense for those who are called to a service with a greater responsibility. Usually you will only be placed within that service once you have passed the test. In the book of Judges, when Gideon called the people of Israel to God's service against the Midianites, 32,000 men applied. At the end of the time in which Gideon had placed his followers through the tests which God appointed, he was left with only 300 men. 32,000 men were **called** but only 300 men passed the tests and were **chosen** for service. Next I looked up the word Disciple in Greek which is MATHETES and means pupil, learner. I looked up Christian in Greek which is CHRISTIANOS and means a follower of Christ. I then looked up Scriptures that teach us what it means to be a disciple.

And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward (Matthew 10:42, KJV).

If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple (Luke 14:26, KJV).

And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple (Luke 14:27, KJV).

So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple (Luke 14:33, KJV). These Scriptures show us that much is expected from a disciple. Does that mean that only those chosen by God to carry a greater anointing and responsibility than others for their specific position can be called disciples?

In hindsight it could appear so, however the Scripture I found that completely contradicts this is ***Hebrews 12:6 - For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives"*** (NKJV). The word disciple comes from discipline. Chastise is another word for discipline. This Scripture clearly shows us that the Lord loves and disciplines every person that He receives – not just the ones chosen to carry more of His Glory. The Lord receives all who turn to Him. This would indicate then that everyone who follows Christ and calls him/herself a Christian is a disciple. To follow Christ however there is a cost and it is not an easy road to walk. A disciple is a follower of Christ. Christ is their teacher and we are His students. Much is expected of a disciple. God disciplines those who follow Him. It is the disciplinarian process that determines if one is to stay a disciple, proceed onto becoming an apostle if that is who God has called you to be or fall away. Interestingly an apostle in Greek is Apostolos which means messenger and also teacher. What is interesting is that a disciple who keeps on following Jesus and allowing Him to guide them through the refining process can become an Apostle. This is indicated in Matthew 10. My conclusions and findings were that a Christian (follower of Christ) and a disciple (pupil) are one and the same. The only difference I can see is that of an Apostle which is different to a disciple. An apostle is when the pupil becomes a teacher. Through researching this I found that the most important thing was really determining whether you are a true Christian – a disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ or a pretend Christian.

It is what you do after you have made Jesus your Lord and Saviour that determines whether you are a true Christian (disciple of Jesus) or a pretend one. What is a pretend Christian? One who chooses to not follow all of Christ's example and lives by their own rules and ways of doing things. What does God say about a pretend Christian? ***“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’ (Matthew 7:21-23, NKJV).***

“I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth (Revelations 3:15-16, NKJV).

God doesn't expect perfection immediately from us but He does expect change. Anyone who wants to follow Christ has to be prepared to be an actual disciple – this means sacrifice and giving up the things of the world. An example of a true disciple is outlined in the Scriptures above. This is the guidelines for every one of us. God however does not expect that change overnight. There are habits and mind-sets as well as weaknesses and wounds to be healed before we can begin to walk as Jesus walked. This is where obedience and willingness to be lead, guided and convicted by the Holy Spirit comes in. So what are you – A true disciple of the living Lord Jesus Christ or a pretend one? If you feel you fall short then ask God for His help in enabling you to become a true disciple and even an apostle of the Lord Jesus Christ.

(PRAYER) – “Father God time is short. I do not want to be luke-warm and I do not want You to say to me that You never knew me. I want to live right by You. I know what it takes to be a true disciple (a follower of Christ) but I know I fall way short of the mark. Please highlight to me all areas where You see I fall short and help me to live as Christ would live. I want You to be proud of the way I live my life and I want to be a good example to fellow Christians and the rest of the world. I give You permission Lord Jesus to continue to change me from the inside out to become who You destined me to be. I pray this in Jesus name, Amen.”

At the end of this I asked the Lord what was the purpose of the imposter giving me the original word. What purpose did it serve? This is what He spoke: - ***“There are many in Christ who view themselves as nobodies. They look to the gifted, the teachers, the prophets, the anointed and the ones they deem as spectacular as being more important than themselves. The nobodies are about to be unleashed. The nobodies are about to become somebodies.***

In me the ones who thought they were of no significance to My Kingdom are about to become significant. I am going to use and utilise all My children in ways they never thought possible. Why did the enemy give you that word? To keep those who believe they are nothing believing they can't be something. Fear would keep them bound. Everybody in My Kingdom has a purpose in Me. Those who are bound can't be released into it. Release them My daughter. Release those who are bound. The ones who thought they weren't important will realise their importance and significance in Me. The favour of God is upon them.”

My Prayer To Those Who Believe They Are Nobodies.

“In the name and power of Jesus Christ I release those who are bound in fear and the belief in the lie that they are ‘insignificant’ and a ‘nobody’ in the Kingdom of God. In Jesus name I declare you to be important, ‘a’ somebody who is significant and anointed

by God. I empower you right now to be released to do all that He has called you to do, in Jesus name, Amen.”

Needs versus Wants – The Holy Spirit once asked me this question – What is trust in God? When He asked me this, it was in fact very timely as I was struggling with trusting in God. My version and mind set of trusting God in all things was I believed I had to trust Him to protect me and those I loved from everything bad. This proved impossible and I couldn't trust Him because bad things were happening everywhere I looked. How could I trust God when all I could see was carnage, doom and gloom? So then, what is trust in God?

This is what the Holy Spirit told me:- *“Trusting in God is knowing that He is for you and not against you. What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? (Romans 8:31, KJV). Trusting God is trusting that no matter what happens He will equip you with what you need. Bad things are the result of unyielded areas and curses in our lives. God will sometimes allow bad things if it can ensure a better or good long-term outcome. If something bad produces something fantastic then God will allow it to come to pass. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose (Romans 8:28, KJV). Trusting God is about provision and that He will supply your every need. But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19, KJV). Protection is part of this provision. Listening to your instincts and taking the means to protect oneself through wisdom is also part of Gods protection such as wearing a seat-belt, not speeding and not walking through a dangerous part of town in the dark. Wisdom also comes into play as God's protection. Many of my children are not making wise choices. Fear is being afraid that God will not provide. If you can trust Me I can supply your every need. Trusting is believing that I am for you and not against you. However I cannot supply everything that man wants – this would turn man into a prideful, selfish person. I can supply man with what He needs although it may not be what he wants! Can you trust Me to supply your every need rather than your every want? You are in the centre of My will and purpose for your life – everything you need is yours, all you have to do is trust and believe that. Trust is believing that I am for you and not against you. Trust is believing (having absolute faith) that I will supply your every need. A need is what God knows You need for Him to do what it is He has called you to do. Heaven and earth are opposite. In Heaven you have everything you want and need. On earth I will supply you all your needs. Why? Does the word not say that I want to bless all My children? Yes with everything they need. What you want and what you need are two different things. Needs are things that one needs to function and be comfortable. I will supply every need if you trust Me. Wants are things that come from a place of pleasure. Pleasure satisfies the flesh. On earth the flesh must be crucified. Its appetites and desires are carnal and not of God. Why then is everything you want available in Heaven. There is no carnality in Heaven. Everything is supplied because the desire comes from God Who wants you to have everything. I cannot give you everything until your flesh is crucified. I can only supply you with what you need. This is a truth that many will find hard to swallow. Acceptance to receive only that which you need is part of moving ahead in God. Always ask and pray what you need and want and I will always supply what you need. Trust this, accept this and the blessings of God will ensue. This is a mind-set My children have. When they don't receive what they want or think they need they no longer trust Me. Pray for Me to supply your every need and I will give them to you – all you have to do is trust.”*

(PRAYER) – “Father God I repent that I lost trust in You because You didn’t give me what I wanted. I repent that I lost trust in You because of bad things happening around me. I now understand the difference between wants and needs. I trust You that You are for me and not against Me. I trust that You will supply my every need. I trust Lord that all things work together for good because I love You and am called according to Your purpose. Thank You that You have revealed this mind-set to me so I can fully trust in you and move ahead into the purpose You have for me, Amen.”

Exchanging God's love - All things living need and want love. God is love and God has designed us to need and want Him in our lives. Sometimes however we can mistake lust for love. The word lust means to have intense sexual desire, or to have a yearning or desire; strong or excessive craving for pleasure. From this we see that lust is not just a sexual thing. The Bible says that God wants to give us the desires of our heart. This can be taken two ways - that He wants to fulfil the things we crave and desire, or that He wants to give us His desires so that we pray and ask for the things God knows we need rather than what we want. I tend to think it would be more the latter. In a session once we had a gentleman who his whole life had been searching for love and never found it. He desired a women to love and was using lust to fulfil his desire for love. He had been searching for love in all the wrong places only to wind up feeling shameful about himself. The Lord told me that a part of his soul was in captivity in a chamber of lust. This meant that he couldn't receive love and didn't even know what real love was. The reason his soul had been taken captive was because he and his ancestors had exchanged Gods love with lust. Instead of searching for the love of God they were fulfilling their lustful appetites with other things.

(PRAYER) - "In Jesus name I repent Father God on behalf of myself and bloodline for exchanging Your love for lust. Please teach me Father God what real love is. Show me what it looks like in comparison to lust. I want to experience Your love in all its glory so that I can receive love, walk in love and impart Your love to others. Thank You, Amen."

Obedience – One day I turned on the television to relax and watch my favourite shows but instead of the television turning on the DVD player came on by itself and started to play a worship CD about intimacy with Jesus. Annoyed I tried to turn it off to no avail. My daughter came out and said “Mum I think God wants you to worship Him instead of watching television”. I chuckled and thought ‘well I better be obedient then’. I sat before the Lord and started singing worship to Him alongside the DVD. After about 10 minutes the presence of the Lord entered and He spoke to me. This is what He said: - ***“Worship is a choice – you can choose to worship or not! Worshipping Me activates My presence. Worshipping Me invites My presence. Worship is about communion and intimacy. When you want to spend time with Me worship Me to activate My presence. Worship is an act of submission. It is an acknowledgement that I and I alone are King. When you activate My presence demons have to flee from you. Worship the Lord your God. This is a commandment. To worship and bow down to Jesus means you are acknowledging Him as your Lord and Saviour. Bow down to Jesus – be submissive to Jesus and the devil will flee from you. Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you (James 4:7-8, NKJV). How do the angels worship? They sing, the bow down, they speak, and they are submissive. Submit means to come under ones authority. Singing is a form of worship. It is a part of being***

subservient but true worship is much more than this. It is being obedient and choosing to follow the Lord. Why did I come and spend time with you tonight? Was it because you sang to Me or was it because you were obedient to My prompting. Obedience is about being submissive. Singing/Praying is part of worship and activates My presence but obedience activates My power.

Are you My daughter obedient to God? Do you choose to obey God every time He speaks to you or every time He prompts you? You claim to be an obedient servant but how obedient are you? Many claim to be obedient to God but they actually are not. Miracles, healings and wholeness are being lost through disobedience. Disobedience is not the same as rebellion. Disobedience = lost opportunities. Choosing to believe what the devil says is disobedience. You are not believing in what I say – instead you believe in what the devil tells you about your circumstances. Obedience to Me is the highest form of worship. Are you obedient to the Spirit of God? You My daughter are obedient to the voice of God every time He prompts you but you are not always obedient to the Spirit of God, nor the word of God. Walking in the Spirit and not in the flesh is walking in obedience to the Spirit of God. Actively seeking and obeying the Word is walking in obedience to the Word of God. You My daughter are a bit hit and miss in these other two areas!

There is a time coming when you worship Me that you will have a face to face encounter. What does this entail? There is a happening, an event about to take place in your life. When this event takes place you will have a choice to believe what God says, or to believe what the devil says. You have free will and free choices – the freedom to choose. True worship is obedience in all three areas of walking in God. You will have a face to face encounter when you enter into all three. When Jesus received the second infilling of the Holy Spirit He actually saw the dove. This was a face to face encounter. A face to face encounter is actively seeing an apparition of God in the natural. You will see with your natural eyes. This is the moment the Kingdom of Heaven is opened up to you. A face to face encounter with the living God.

(PRAYER) – “Father God in Jesus name I repent for lack of obedience in all three areas of worship to You. These areas are obedience to Your voice, obedience to the Spirit of God and obedience to the Word of God. Father God thank You that You will provide opportunities for me to be able to enter into all three forms of worship to You. I pray for a face to face encounter with You that will change my life forever. I am willing to be subservient to You in all aspects of my life, so that Your glory can rest upon Me, so I can bring whatever is needed straight from the Kingdom to Your children. Amen.”

Exchanging Your Weakness for Strength – How long have you been waiting for your promises in God? I know for myself it seems like an eternity. It is probably taking every ounce of your strength not to give up and concede defeat. Whatever you do, do not give up or concede defeat. There is hope! Today the Lord answered the prayer of a client we were ministering to. He received his promise and right before our eyes He was infilled with the Holy Spirit and just started worshipping and praising the Lord. For a long time He hadn't been able to worship the Lord. His heart was full of bitterness. He had come to a bad place in his walk with the Lord. What a sight to see this man full of the Spirit singing, crying, praising and

worshipping. He told us at the end that he had never ever before had such an encounter with the Lord. It was a beautiful sight to behold. During this session with this gentlemen who was exactly in this place of waiting I saw a vision of a rainbow and this is what the Lord spoke in regard to the rainbow: - ***“Rainbows signify God’s promise. Your promise is about to come to pass. Waiting, waiting, waiting. The waiting time is over. I am calling you by name. It is your turn. I haven’t forgotten or forsaken you. I tested your heart. I tested Peter’s heart. Three times I asked him if he loved me. Do you love Me? Can you forgive Me for making you wait? But those who wait on the LORD, Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31, NKJV). Give him wings. Time to fly. Rest in Me. No more striving. No more battling. Things will become easier. Let my strengths overcome your weaknesses. Lay down your weaknesses at the foot of the cross but first rejoice in them. Thank Me for them so that the power of Christ may rest upon them.”*** ***And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong (2 Corinthians 12:7-10, NKJV).***

(PRAYER) – (Prophetic Act) – Lay down your weaknesses at the foot of the cross. “I give up my weaknesses to You Lord Jesus. I thank You Father God for these weaknesses so that the power of Christ may rest upon them. I forgive You Father God for making me wait for my promises. I love You. Lord Jesus I have given all I can in my own strength. Time for You to impart Your empowering grace and strength into me. My weaknesses were thorns Lord that You gave me ‘lest I become proud’. Thank You for removing pride from me. Immerse me in Your humility. Immerse me in Your strength. Infill my soul Lord Jesus. Yes I pray, infill my soul Lord Jesus. I accept, I accept. I accept You Lord Jesus Christ my Prince, my King, my Lord and my Saviour. Fill me, fill me with Your love. Fill me with Your grace. Fill me with Your compassion. Fill me with Your hope. Fill me with the attributes of Christ. Make me who You ordained me to be since the beginning of time. Peace Lord Jesus, peace. Fill me with Your Spirit. Fill me to overflowing. Take me by the hand Lord Jesus and take me to where You want me to go. Let your light shine through me wherever I go. Change me, love me, and nurture me. Take me to the ends of the earth and back. Take me to where you need me to be. Healing Lord, healing. Infill me, infill me. Thank You, thank You. I praise Your wonderful name. I give all honour, glory and praise to the one true King – the living Lord Jesus Christ – who was, and is, and is to come, Amen!”

Diligently Seeking Him – Six years ago a visiting prophet in a Church I was attending gave me a word. This word was that God was going to heal everything that was wrong with me. At the time I was doing well except for some abnormal uterine bleeding. I believed that the word was for this. This condition lasted four

years as I transitioned into the menopause transition. I had also been given a word from another gentlemen a few years earlier that I was going to be tested and that testing was going to be hard but not to worry because Jesus had prayed that my faith would never fail (**Luke 22:32**). Fast forward to the present day in which more and more things have gone wrong in my physical body - to the point I had to give up Ministry. During this time of giving up the Lord promised also that He was going to do a new thing with the Ministry. I wondered how that would happen given how unwell I was. This word given to me by the prophet of God was confirmed by other people over that six year period. I clung to that word and hoped that it was true but circumstances made it appear that it was wrong. Instead of getting better I got worse and worse. I believed I had been obedient to God obeying everything He asked of me. There were times that I felt so hurt and disappointed because it seemed that God was not fulfilling His promise to me.

On 9/7/2017 a friend who I hadn't spoken to in ages texted me and said she had received a vision and a word for me. She saw me and I was split in two – one side of me was dark and the other light. I knew she was seeing my spirit (which was filled with the Holy Spirit) and my soul (which was not yet transformed). God had been speaking to me about a second infilling of His Holy Spirit into my soul where I would be healed and walk in more of His power. She was also told that the enemy had been trying to steal my faith. She was given Hebrews 11:1 and told me to keep reading until I needed to stop. I got to Hebrews 11:6 and that verse literally leapt of the page to me. ***But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6, NKJV).*** My initial understanding of this verse was that it would be counted as faith if I believed God was a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. I pondered it and realised that in the beginning I believed 100% in my promise and that God was a rewarder but because it had tarried and I had become much worse I was at times doubting the promise. I was even doubting Gods goodness. I had even told Him on occasion that I thought He was mean. As I was pondering I heard the Lords voice ***“Do you believe I am a rewarder? You have developed a mind-set – one that says ‘You may not get what I promised’. If I have made you a promise you must believe that I will give you that promise – this is faith. Do you remember in the beginning when I told you that you wouldn’t be healed until you trusted me? Negativity says ‘What if this promise doesn’t happen. Faith according to the word of God is that you believe I am God and that I will reward those who diligently seek Me. You do not fully believe this because you believe you have diligently sought Me and I have not rewarded you. The enemy comes to sow doubt. As you go through a trial the enemy tells you that I am not helping you. To receive My promise you have to keep believing until the promise comes. Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But when the desire comes, it is a tree of life (Proverbs 13:12, NKJV). Waiting is hard. Faith starts to wane. It is human nature to disbelieve the promise when the trials come. It is human nature to enter into doubt because the promise or desire of your heart tarries. Why do I take so long to fulfil the promise? Surely it is My fault that you lose faith. No it is not, for I am testing your heart to see if you love Me. Did Jesus not ask Peter three times if he loved Him? This represents the testing of your heart. God rewards those who diligently seek Him. This means that those who remain in Me after the testing receive the promise. Diligently seeking Me is continuing to wait on Me and remain in Me throughout the trial. Those who walk away or give up hoping in Me for their promise are not diligently seeking Me. If you do not abandon Me***

then I will not/ cannot abandon you or your promise. I test your heart to see if you will remain in Me. If you remain in Me this is trust and this is faith. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you (John 15:7, NKJV). True faith My daughter does not happen overnight. It is grown through continuing to walk with Me amid the trials even when it feels as though I am far from you. Diligently seeking Me is not letting Me go no matter what the circumstances are showing you. You now have a choice to make. I will ask you this question – ‘Do you believe I am a rewarder of those who diligently seek Me?’” After the Lord had shown me the true definition of rewarding those who diligently seek Him I could answer with a heartfelt yes. I truly did now believe this because I understood what I had been walking through. How could God reward me if I didn't believe He was a rewarder? How could God reward me if I didn't believe He was good? The promise had tarried for so long that the enemy had sowed a seed of doubt in me that God was good. The truth was that God had been growing my faith because I had been diligently seeking Him the entire time. I had never let Him go. I continued to hold on to Him and keep hoping that His promise to me would happen. This is also trust and faith because of the refusal to let God go because deep down in your heart you know that He is trustworthy. Here I had been believing I had lost my faith when in reality He had been growing my faith. God's ways sure are not our ways!

(PRAYER) - “Father God in Jesus name I repent for any doubt in Your goodness. I repent and confess as sin the times I doubted You were a rewarder of those who diligently seek You. Thank You for clarifying ‘diligently seeking You’ is those who continue to seek, walk and hope in You even though Your promises tarry. Thank You Jesus that you have prayed that my faith will never fail me. Thank You for growing my faith in You. If Jesus has asked me three times if I love Him, the answer is yes. I love the Lord Jesus Christ, Father God and His Holy Spirit with all my heart, soul and mind. I confess that I solemnly believe that You are God and that You are a rewarder of those who diligently seek You, Amen.”

Be Still and Know – The other day I received an email from a lady who was asking for help as she was suffering extreme anxiety. She informed me that she was so bad that she had been admitted to psychiatric wards and was on a myriad of medication all of which was not helping. She was in a desperate situation. I read her email and felt helpless because I did not yet have the victory over anxiety. I too was suffering, to the point that it was interfering with daily life. I went to God and said “How do I help this lady through Jesus Christ when I haven't been helped yet myself. You have given me many keys but yet I am still suffering. All I can do is offer this lady worldly advice of coping mechanisms because I do not yet have the victory over this.” The Lord said **“Ask Me to give you the victory so you can help her. I have the solution for you. Peace! All you need is My peace. All she needs is My peace.”** I had previously received words from others, one especially that stood out. A prophetess had once told me that I was a peacemaker and that I would walk in peace and teach others how to attain it. I asked the Lord “What is blocking me still from receiving your peace?” The Lord spoke and said **“Be still and know that I am God.”** I then saw a vision of a whirlwind. I was caught smack bang in the centre of it. I then saw a hand reaching down from above. I grabbed it and the hand lifted me up and out of the whirlwind.

I then heard these Scriptures. ***Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm Mark 4:39, NKJV).***

Then she said, "Sit still, my daughter, until you know how the matter will turn out; for the man will not rest until he has concluded the matter this day" (Ruth 3:18, NKJV).

Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth (Psalm 46:10, KJV).

The Lord then asked me what 'being still meant'. I replied with "I believe it means to trust in you." He asked me to find out the meaning of the original word 'still' in Hebrew and Greek in relation to those three Scriptures? I did this and this is what I found. In the Scripture **Mark 4:39** the word still in Greek is **Phimoo** and means put to silence. In **Ruth 3:18** the word still in Hebrew is **Yashab** and means to remain, to dwell, sit and abide. In Psalm **46:10** the word 'still' in Hebrew is **Raphah** and means feeble, weaken, fail, and faint. He then asked me to put **Psalm 46:10** in its correct context. ***Be weak, feeble and faint and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.***

This is what He then spoke, ***"That which is strong does not need me. That which is weak always needs Me. I need your strengths and your weaknesses for My Kingdom. I pull out both – first your strengths, then your weaknesses. When you can no longer go on (becoming feeble and weak) I can then give you My strengths. I bring you to the end of yourself. That is why the walk is so hard. The walk of Christ is about strengths and weakness. I cannot fully launch you into the call of God until I have successfully pulled out both. You need rescuing My daughter. I am the rescuer. I do not like to see My children struggling. It pains Me so, but it is for the good of the Kingdom to allow these trials to refine you. You have been through the refiner's fire. You have been tested and tried. When you first received Me you were born-again in your human spirit. You become born-again in your human soul after you have been through the baptism of fire. Jesus baptises you with Spirit and fire. I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire (Matthew 3:11, NKJV). Your human soul (mind, will and emotions) which is also your heart needs to come into alignment with the Kingdom otherwise you 'see' in a worldly sense. I need you to 'see' in the Spirit at all times. I need you to be in the Spirit at all times.***

Being born-again in your soul is not an automatic thing – it is done through the sanctification process. Have you been still before the Lord? Have you come to the end of yourself so My Spirit can enter your human soul? Are you ready for the second infilling of My Holy Spirit? Are you ready to be reborn in spirit and in soul? Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thessalonians 5:23, NKJV). "Yes absolutely" I answered. The Lord spoke ***"If you still choose to offer your heart to Me after the trials and the refining of your soul, then that is when I accept it, and in return give to you My heart. This is where the true exchange takes***

place. Our hearts cannot be exchanged until you truly understand and know what it is you are doing, and what it is you are giving up. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them (Ezekiel 36:26-27, NKJV).

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus (Philippians 2:5, NKJV). I cannot take the heart of one who isn't truly ready. I am a gentleman and can only accept what is offered to Me when you have the true knowledge of what it means to carry My heart within you."

Prayer of release the Lord gave to me to pray: "Jesus Christ I offered You my heart when I first asked You into my heart. You then searched my heart to see if there were any areas in which I was holding back from you. Through revelation from Your Holy Spirit you revealed these areas to me and gave me a choice – to hang onto them or allow You into them. I chose You Lord Jesus, I always choose You. I come again to You on this day, battle-worn, tested and tried and again offer to You my heart. I ask You Lord Jesus Christ into my heart. No matter the trials, no matter the tests I will always choose you because I trust You with one of my most sacred possessions, my heart!"

The Lord then spoke *"The peace comes when I 'still' (put to silence) the storm coming against you. Before I can 'still' the storm you must first become weak, feeble and faint before Me. This is so I can be glorified in you. The exchange of our hearts will happen at exactly the right moment in exactly the right place. In this time you will receive My peace to still the storm in your battered soul. Peace be still and know that I am God, and that I will be exalted among the earth."*

Reliance on Jesus – For almost two years my nervous system had been stuck in flight or fight 24/7. I had tried almost everything there was to offer to help and nothing did. Some things even made me much worse. Sleeping had become a real problem – I was taking ages to go to sleep because of the adrenaline surges and heart palpitations. Once asleep I was waking every two to three hours with hot flashes that left me sweating from top to toe alongside surges of adrenaline and a pounding heartbeat. Menopause was really hitting me hard. I spent pretty much most of my life avoiding stress because whenever I got stressed, fearful or excited the pounding and surging would just escalate. Many times it felt as though I was on the verge of a heart attack. Good days for me were when it wasn't unbearable and I could grin and bear it, but in this whole time I had not felt any peace in my physical body. Life had become avoiding anything stressful. It had gotten to the point where I didn't even like driving anymore as this always caused me to be on hyper alert and then the stress would escalate. I was relying on Mark more and more to drive us all too where we needed to go. This meant that I was even avoiding taking the kids to the doctor, their friends, the shops etc..... I felt bad and hated being a burden.

On bad days there were times were I literally felt like I couldn't do it anymore. My mum happened to ring during one of these times and I just sobbed and sobbed over

the phone to her. I cried and said “I don’t know what else to do anymore, I have tried everything and nothing works. I am literally stuck with nowhere to turn.” Not long after I got off the phone I heard the Lord speak, **“I have something to tell you if you are willing to hear. I have an answer for you.”** Armed with pen and paper I sat down on my bed ready to receive.

This is what I got: - **“Brokenness – this is the point of no return. Stalemate – no answers for you outside of Christ. I have to get you to this place. This is for you to see that outside of Me you can do nothing. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing (John 15:5, NKJV). Reliance on Me = Trust in Me. Remember when I told you that I would not heal you until you trusted Me. This means that I need for you to rely solely on Me.”** **Were the Ethiopians and the Lubim not a huge army with very many chariots and horsemen? Yet, because you relied on the LORD, He delivered them into your hand (2 Chronicles 16:8, NKJV).** The word relied on here in Hebrew is Sha’an and means to lean on, trust in, support. Of trust in God. **“Have you exhausted every option where there is nothing left but Me? This is where I have been taking you. Before you can trust Me you first have to rely upon Me. I need to bring you to the end of yourself. This is the moment where you see there is nothing left outside of Me. This is when you let go and let God. When you have accepted there is nowhere else to turn and rely solely upon Me, this is where God comes through. I told you that I would heal you, yet you continue to seek for answers outside of Me. Coping Mechanisms. Trust = reliance upon Me. Why does it have to be this way? This is where you die to self. I remove ‘the world’ and give you ‘My world’, the Kingdom and all it has to offer. What do you have to do to ‘let go and let God’? You have to come to the end of yourself. This is coming to a stalemate against yourself – what is your next move? Nothing, there is no next move because you have exhausted every option. Where there is no hope in anything apart from Jesus Christ – that is where I am taking you. If you want to be used by Me this is where I have to take you. Reliance on Christ.”**

(PRAYER) – “I surrender Lord Jesus Christ. In my own strength I have tried to help myself. Nothing has worked. You are my only hope, my only option. Nothing outside of You has helped me. Reliance upon You equals trust in You. I rely upon You to deliver me. I depend upon You to heal me. I need You Lord Jesus to heal me. The spirit of self-sufficiency says ‘I can do it’. Lord Jesus the truth is ‘I cannot do it without You, without You I can do nothing. I need You. I need You as my Lord and Saviour.”

“When you are first saved you invite Jesus to be your Lord and Saviour. Why is it so important that he fulfils this role? So He gets all the glory! To enter into His glory you must first give Him all the glory. If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen (1 Peter 4:11, NKJV). Man loves to be glorified. Man seeks acceptance and approval. ALL GLORY BELONGS TO JESUS CHRIST. Before you can enter into His glory He has to be glorified in you.” **Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of**

our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ (2 Thessalonians 1:11-12, NKJV). (The word for glorified in Greek is **doxazo** and means honour, to praise, extol, magnify, and celebrate). ***“How is He glorified in you? When He strengthens you and you render to Him all the glory, the honour and the praise.”***

I then realised that the Lord was showing me in order to truly give Jesus all the glory we have to be brought to such a place of brokenness, that His healing in that place will produce in us such gratitude, celebration, exaltation and praise toward Jesus for what He has done, that there will be no room left in us for such things as pride and self-exaltation. The Lord told me a long time ago that if He gave us His power at the same level Jesus walked in before we were ready and refined, that pride would destroy us. We would go around thinking we were God, or that we were more important than others because of the great power we are walking in. This way He is showing us our brokenness and that we can only walk in His greatness and power when His strength is poured into that brokenness. No room for us and our ego. We will see only what Jesus has done, and through glorifying Jesus He can then shine His glory through us which has a flow on effect to others. Through this He is removing the self-sufficient spirit which thinks that it can do all things, in order for us to see that we can only do all things through Christ who strengthens us (**Philippians 4:13**).

Walls, Structures and Systems - Many years ago I received a word from a Minister who told me that ‘I would raise up teams of people’. What did this look like? I did not know. I assumed it was raising up Ministry Teams using the same Ministry Model I was using. I was saved in 2009 and begun our own Team Ministry Sessions in 2011. For five years I (Tania) lead a Team Ministry from our home. The Ministry was all about laying down self and trusting God to show us (and the client) what needed to be done rather than asking for ‘what we wanted done’ as that is what He had spoken to me as being the main emphasis of the Ministry sessions. I then prayed to God and asked Him to help me develop a Ministry Model. I had been to a couple of Ministry Training sessions with other Ministries who each used a specific model or method that they taught. Being a person that loves to follow structures and rules (rather than spontaneity) I took what I had learned and developed a Ministry Model and made sure it was all Scripturally sound and correct. Over time I added more and more to it because I was afraid I would forget to do something important. The protection prayer got huge, the checklist became large and the end prayer had everything I could think of to cover all our bases.

During that time of doing Team Ministry I started to become very unwell, to the point I had to lay it down in October 2016. When I laid it down the Lord revealed to me that although He was very much in the Ministry sessions we had been doing I had quenched the work of the Holy Spirit because of the fact that I had added so much safety nets to our sessions. He showed me this was because I hadn’t trusted Him enough and that the Ministry Model I used was from my own thoughts and ideas. In that moment He gave me a word about Methods, Models and Formulas. This was the word: -

Methods, Models and Formulas - “The body of Christ has introduced methods and ways of healing. Jesus Christ is the healer – He is the same today, yesterday and forever. I will not be put in a box. It is about getting back to basics – doing it as Jesus did. No frills or gimmickry just the pureness of God. Methods = mind-sets. I use many different ways. Ministry methods should be a guideline only. I will not, cannot be put in a box to be used as a formula. I will do it different every time. I used many different ways to heal. Not one is greater than another. No set formulas – freedom for Me to move.

Christian Connection will be unique in the sense it will have no Ministry Model. There will be no set formula. The prayers on the website are not a formula. They are designed to teach people about the blockages between you and God. Jesus is the intermediary Who removes the blockages. Reliance on Jesus. The prayers are for teaching purposes. The prayers are for healing. The prayers are for guidance. Team Ministry as it was is no longer. I may call you out into the market place. I may send you to people who need your wisdom, guidance and testimonies. The Team method you used is now null and void and will no longer be used. You will use a guideline only.”

I prayed immediately for the guideline and received this: -

- 1) Pray a prayer of protection**
- 2) Worship and Praise as this activates My presence**
- 3) Pray in tongues as this allows the Holy Spirit to intercede for you**
- 4) Ask Me to show you what the client needs (Take time and write it down)**
- 5) Ask the client to ask Jesus what they would like Him to do for them**
- 6) Pray/Break/Intercede (whatever is needed from what is shown). Each individual Team member deals with his/her thing with the client separately. Each pair of the body working together with My anointing in them. Each Team member interacting one on one with the client.**
- 7) Lay hands and infill with God’s love, light and peace.**

At the time I believed it was from God as it was so much more refined than my original Team Ministry Model, so I put it aside and waited as God had told me it was my time to rest in Him and wait for Him to relaunch the Ministry into a ‘New thing’. Over those two years I had many deceiving spirits giving me direction into what the New Ministry was. Neither of these things gave me that absolute peace and knowing so I just continued to wait. Occasionally I did ponder this guideline though and often thought it looked more like a formula than a guideline but I wasn’t sure one way or another.

In November 2018 I heard clearly from the Lord and He told me to pick up my mantle again and the ‘New Ministry’ was to simply be available to minister to whomever He sent my way and to be available wherever He sent me. He also told me that my healing would come in His presence when I was under the anointing ministering to others, and that I had already been imparted a double anointing that would be activated when I stepped into it.

A month earlier prior to receiving this word I got asked to join a prayer group with a group of woman. Feeling still very unwell I decided to push myself and join. We

planned meet once a month but now meet once a week. The lady who owned the house and ran the prayer group asked us if we would mind praying for a gentlemen she had met that had many needs. I prayed and asked if I was to use the new guideline I was given two years earlier. I felt that I was to bring it with me but still wasn't 100% sure as God had shown me that He wanted me to work more spontaneously in Him without so much structure. I discussed it with the other ladies and one of them felt I was not to use it and that there didn't need to be a Team leader leading the session and to just let the Holy Spirit flow and use our gifts. I felt that although God loves spontaneity there is still some order needed for a Ministry session to flow smoothly otherwise it could become dysfunctional. The ladies agreed that I would lead the session. The ministry session went very well although I didn't follow the guideline 100% as I was still waiting for confirmation from the Lord.

The next week our prayer group was asked to minister to another person that needed ministry. I arrived with my guideline in hand again and I had only just sat down when the Holy Spirit came upon us all and we all flowed in our gifting's, no one leading for nearly two hours. To be honest it was the best Ministry session I had ever attended. Arriving home that afternoon I felt very confused because the week before I used the guideline and that day I had not. I needed to keep praying about this and I wondered if the other lady was right and I was not supposed to use any guideline at all – maybe the key was just to be available. The week before I lead it using the guideline and it was great, today no one had lead it, there was no guideline and it was even better! I sought the Lord and told Him how I was confused and asked Him to show me exactly what He wanted me to be doing. Immediately I received a word with the peace and knowing and this is what I heard: -

***“Walls, structures and systems – you are bound by them. The world system lives by them. Man likes to have structures in place as this gives a sense of protection. More often than not it is ‘false protection’. Jesus lived each day by following the leading of the His Father. He did not know from one day to the next what was in store for Him. He does not even know the day in which He is coming again, only the Father knows. This is hard for you because you like order. In God, removing the walls is not going to create disorder because it will cause you to rely fully on Me. Letting go of control enables you to let Me be in control. Whatever you need for ministering I will show you. Every disciple of Jesus needs to live a life of Bible reading, prayer, praying in tongues and worship and praise as this allows you to connect with Me on a Spirit to spirit level. You need to nurture and feed your spirit with the things of God on a daily basis. The world makes the rules. Just because I do something once does not mean I will do it again or that you should make a doctrine from it. The Ministry guideline is a guide you should use and live by at all times. The Ministry guideline is this ‘**Make yourself available for Me to use whenever and wherever you go!**’ I will send you out and I will send people to you. Get familiar with the Prayers (PDF’s) because they are what you will use to minister to set the captives free. If there is anything new that you need to know, trust Me to show you. The New Ministry is simply about being available. This is what you will teach. It is not about formulas, checklists, models, rules and regulations. It is about availability. As long as you are available I will use you. Do you need to be an expert? No, but you need to know My word, My character and My voice.*”**

The blockages that the prayers on your PDF removed gave you the ability to receive more of Me. The more of Me you have, the more of My power you carry. Less of you means more of Me! The prayers are designed to remove those things that hinder My flow. Every single person needs to have those things that hinder you from receiving from Me removed from them. It is in the best interest of all My children to learn what they are, and to have them removed. Lay down your love of rules, regulations and structures so you can operate by following the will of God simply by allowing the Holy Spirit to lead and guide you in all things.”

I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye (Psalm 32:8, KJV). (Interestingly the word guide in this passage in Hebrew is **Ya’ats** and means to advise, give counsel). By this I knew that the first guideline I was given was not from God. That clearly was given to me by a deceiving spirit. Although it was refined and even based on scripture it would have only locked me up in methods and formulas again, which ultimately quenches the leading of the Holy Spirit. The new guideline for the New Ministry that I was to live by and teach to others was very simple, “To make yourself available for God to use whenever and wherever you go”.

(PRAYER) – “Father God I repent for my love of rules, regulations, structures, methods, models and man-made systems. I lay these down and declare **‘I make myself available for You to use whenever and wherever I go’**. I pray that the Holy Spirit would lead and guide me in all things. I want to live a life pleasing to God. I lay down control and my own agendas. I repent for the need to have a system in place because I did not trust enough in the leading of the Holy Spirit. I am sorry Holy Spirit for quenching You, In Jesus name, Amen.”

Let Go and Let God – When you suffer from fear you will know how easy it is to become trapped in a world of ‘controlling your own circumstances’ to keep yourself safe. I was a by-product of how wounds shape you. All the bad things in my life that had happened to me kept me bound in fear. I only had peace and security when I had searched my surroundings and done all I could to keep me and my family safe. My whole life consisted of safety checks and avoidance of things that I couldn’t control. I never once stopped to actually ‘smell the roses’ as I was always on the lookout for the thorns. As you can imagine this is very tiring alongside of the fact that I was a perfectionist and needed everything in order and in its place.

God gave me a word whilst I was suffering from my body being stuck in flight or fight (which had been going on now for three years due to the menopause transition and various other ailments which made life very hard) to start ministering again. I agreed because He gave me a promise that I would be healed in His presence whilst I ministered to others. He also gave me a double portion of His anointing in order to do this. As I started ministering again I noticed indeed I had been given a greater portion of anointing – the fruit of the Ministry was fantastic. After a month of ministering to others I noticed that my symptoms had gotten worse and not better. I definitely had been strengthened by God to push through and do this but my actual symptoms were still very bad. On top of this we had an accident with our fish tank one night whilst in bed where it sprang a massive leak and ruined the carpet in our lounge, dining room and computer room, as well as the wall adjoining between them.

Thankfully we had insurance as these all needed replacing. Our carpet was 18 years old so it really was a blessing. We also got gifted a brand new fish tank and all of the fish survived the transition. Because the insurance only replaces where there is actual damage we decided to re-carpet the rest of the house to match with the new carpet because Marks parents kindly offered to help toward the cost. This was a huge undertaking as we had accumulated a lot of clutter over the years and decided to have a massive clean out and spring clean while we were at it. Mark and I worked very hard over that month and being unwell it hit me pretty hard. I also found that now I had another thing to fret over, 'the new carpet'. I went all out into Rambo mode and worry over people ruining our new carpet and put safety measures in place.

The weekend after we had finished I had a melt-down. I wasn't sleeping well due to adrenaline rushes and night sweats continually throughout the night and my entire body was sore due to muscle strain and spasms. On top of this it was now school holidays and my children (now 14 and 17) were off out with their friends in the big wide world without me. They were at that age where I could no longer be with them and be their protection anymore. It was time for them to venture out alone. It was all too much and one afternoon I suffered a panic attack. Mark told me to put my trust in God and I answered with 'How can I when God can't guarantee nothing bad won't happen to me, you or our children'. Everywhere I looked Christians were suffering. I cried out to God through my many sobs and told Him over and over that 'I didn't want to take control of everything anymore because it was too hard and I needed Him to help.' This is what I believe He spoke to me during my anguish, ***"You have built a wall of protection around yourself. It is called 'Fear of letting go'. You won't let go of control. Fear dictates your life. Fear dictates your boundaries. There is only so far you can go in Me when fear stops you going any further. I cannot take you to where I want you to go because fear dictates your boundaries in Me. You have to control everything in order to feel safe. I am removing control from you. I cannot be in control when you don't give it to Me. You told your husband 'That God cannot guarantee that nothing bad won't happen to me or my children'. This mind-set prevents you letting go."*** I then remembered I had written a revelation about this called 'Fear of being hurt' in which God had confirmed that 'until one leaves this fallen world' He cannot guarantee that 'nothing bad' won't happen to you as this is a natural consequence to sin and unyielded areas operating in our lives. There is always a reaping and sowing effect in place. He spoke again, ***"If you allow Me to remove every blockage in your life between Me and you that hinders the blessings then I can guarantee that to you. It is only those things in you or around you that are not of Me that can cause bad things. When you are outworking every blockage I can turn all things that are bad to good because you are Mine. And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28, NKJV). I want to remove the world from you. When you are separate from the world you and your family can live a life of blessing. These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world"*** (John 16:33, NKJV).

Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you" (2 Corinthians 6:17, NKJV).

Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Corinthians 7:1, NKJV). When I remove the world from you, I remove all that is within the world – hurt, pain, grief, sickness and trauma all from you too. Do you understand? In Me you bring Heaven to earth. You live and reign in Heavenly places. You are seated with Christ in Heavenly places. In My Kingdom there is no death, no hurt, no pain and no sickness. You can have all that You desire here on earth but first you have to be willing to let go of the world and everything in it.” **But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you (Matthew 6:33, NKJV).** It was then that I realised the previous word where God had told me that He couldn’t give me this guarantee of security and protection until one had left this fallen world also applied to being completely separate from the world. This happens through the sanctification process and when you surrender all to Jesus. I had assumed it had meant you had to either physically die and go to Heaven or wait until His return before you could walk in this bubble of guaranteed blessing and protection. What God was showing me was that you can get to this place of complete wholeness, blessing and protection in Him when you are willing to totally let go. He spoke again, **“Trust Me to supply your every need. When you are glorified you will leave behind the world and live and reign in the Kingdom. You bring Heaven to Earth. Jesus in you. The Kingdom within you. You will live in peace, without fear. You have now laid down that wall of self-protection called ‘fear of letting go’. I had to bring you to a place where controlling your environment became too hard for you. Only when you are in this place can you truly lay it down and give it to Me. It was an unyielded area. You had to be brought to a place where you could no longer physically do it. You are mentally and physically exhausted. Your body is locked in flight or fight because you have put yourself there. Controlling everything means when all is in its place you feel safe and have peace. When you are not in control you cannot rest. Your hormones are out of control because of the menopause transition – this means your body cannot rest. Under normal circumstances the body can readjust and establish equilibrium during times of change but for you it cannot because you have put yourself in this place called ‘fear of letting go’ and are locked there. How do you get out? I have the key. Let go and let God! Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit no matter the circumstances. Stay on course and continue to do as I asked.**

Minister to the people and be available whenever and wherever you go. You asked Me a question, ‘Why have you not yet seen your healing manifest’? Firstly you had to lay down that wall and let go of control. You had declared to Me many times that you let go of control but it is not until you are in the moment that you can actually do this. Brokenness enables you to surrender. Only I can see the heart and determine when you have actually let go and given to Me those areas that you hold onto. What does this mean for you now? Freedom. As previously spoken to you, as you let go and let God you will be raised up into the new creation. Once the blockages are removed all that needs to happen is ‘Me’ in you resurrecting you into the new Christ-like creation. How will it happen? When you enter into My presence. Your soul will be born-again. Will it be all at once or in stages? Deliverance and healing go hand and hand. For some they are being made new piece by piece, bit by

bit but for you it will all happen at once. Your Ministry is about removing blockages between you and Me so that you can receive all that I have for you. You will teach this, but not only that, you will be a vessel of this. When the last blockage is removed from you, you will be infilled with My Holy Spirit and things will become new. You have been waiting for the second infilling of the Holy Spirit into your soul and believed it would be a momentous occasion because of all the words I have spoken to you, but then changed your thinking believing it to be gradual each time you stepped into my presence because I have already given you the anointing to pick up your mantle which is activated as you step out in faith. The anointing which is activated when you step out in faith is the ladder in which you will climb to your God-given destiny. Your greatest blockage is not trusting Me. As you obey the Holy Spirit and step into the anointing you will meet with Me when you reach the top.” I then asked God, “Where is the ladder, and where am I climbing out of?” He replied, **“The world!”** **Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it (Genesis 28:12, NKJV).**

(PRAYER) – “Lord Jesus I come before you and ask that You would show me all things that prevent me from climbing the ladder from this world into the Heavenly realms and into my God-given destiny.” *(Write them down).*

I repent for holding onto these things and for not letting them go. Please bring me to a place where I can truly lay them down and let them go. I let go and let God – I surrender to You. I want to give up all I have to follow You. I ask the Holy Spirit to give me clear instructions on what I have to do to make it happen. Show me the ladder Lord Jesus and please give me the anointing to climb the ladder. I want to meet with You at the top and become all that You desire for me to be. Thank You Father, Son and Holy Spirit that although in the world there is tribulation I can have peace because You have overcome the world, Amen.”

Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also (Matthew 6:19-21, NKJV).

Pleading Your Cause - Eight months ago the Lord told me if I entered back into Ministry again I would be healed under the anointing as I prayed for others. This was also confirmed by a visiting minister when I attended a healing Ministry meeting. I was obedient and picked up my mantle and started ministering again. When I first started (although it was hard) my symptoms became more bearable and I could see that God had given me the strength to do the ministering. Over the last month however my symptoms have become awful again. I couldn't understand what was going on. This last week I was feeling particularly awful so I reminded God of His promise and felt so hurt that it hadn't happened yet. To be honest I believe the enemy did a number on me in this time and I became quite depressed and full of self-pity. I even said to Mark that I felt tempted to quit and walk away because the waiting for promises to be fulfilled is excruciating when you are suffering. I started believing that God was just horrible and not for me at all and that this walk seemed

to be just never-ending suffering. Everywhere I looked were suffering people who were needing their miracles and none seemed to be making much progress toward this. When I feel like this I tend to draw inward, away from God rather than toward God which is not good as Mark so kindly points out. Mark kept encouraging me to pray in tongues and seek God but I became stubborn and refused because I was overwhelmed, discouraged and hurting so couldn't bring myself to do it. In fact I felt very anti-God in this moment and instead of trusting and believing in my promises I kept arguing my case before Him.

Before my time of writing this I got sent a word from a friend that I was to forward on for someone else and they had included a Scripture that piqued my interest. This was the scripture: - ***I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, and I shall behold his righteousness. (Micah 7:9, KJV).*** The reason this piqued my interest was because it reminded me of those who enter into the Courtroom of God to plead their cause. I had written before on why I believe this is deception and my reasons for this but I had never seen this Scripture before and how it may apply to this. Time to do a bit more study!

We know by Scripture that there is a Heavenly Courtroom and the accuser of the brethren continually comes before the Throne of God to accuse us. In the courtroom ministry scenario you come before God as your judge to plead your cause and you ask Jesus to be your advocate. The devil is also invited to bring accusation against you so you can battle against Him and break his legal rights over you. What does the word of God say about pleading our cause? ***Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them. (Proverbs 22:22-23, KJV).***

Their Redeemer is strong; the LORD of hosts is his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon. (Jeremiah 50:34, KJV). By the above scriptures we can see clearly that the **Lord pleads our cause** – not us. Interestingly the word 'He shall plead my cause' in Hebrew is **Riyb** and means to 1) strive, contend, controversy, dispute 1a) strife, quarrel **1b) conduct a case or suit**. This is different to petitioning, praying, asking and seeking, which we are called to do. We need to trust Jesus to plead our cause for us on our behalf. If we take over this role we are doing His job for Him. Is the spirit of self-sufficiency in us saying we can do it better? This is pride and we need to let go and allow Jesus to do this for us on our behalf. We need to leave the courtroom and what goes on up there to Jesus to contend with. He is our advocate who pleads our cause on our behalf. ***My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. (1 John 2:1-2, KJV).***

The word advocate in this Scripture is **Parakletos** in Greek and means 1) summoned, called to one's side, esp. called to one's aid 1a) one who pleads another's cause before a judge, a pleader, counsel for defense, legal assistant, an advocate 1b) one who pleads another's cause with one, an intercessor 1b1) of Christ in his exaltation at God's right hand, pleading with God the Father for the pardon of our sins 1c) in the widest sense, a helper, succourer, aider, assistant 1c1) of the

Holy Spirit destined to take the place of Christ with the apostles (after his ascension to the Father), to lead them to a deeper knowledge of the gospel truth, and give them divine strength needed to enable them to undergo trials and persecutions on behalf of the divine kingdom.

As I was writing this God gave me a revelation. Although He had shown me that coming before God as a judge to plead your cause using the Courtroom Ministry was deception (as it was taking it out of the hands of Jesus), He also showed me that 'pleading our cause before Him' can also happen daily in ignorance. In fact I had done this very thing myself in my time of despair and discouragement as I had been arguing my case before Him. He showed me that this was the wrong way to deal with it and I was consequently tying the hands of Jesus and the Holy Spirit to act on my behalf. How many times have you argued with God and tried to defend your cause? The scriptures say that the Lord will vindicate and exercise justice on our behalf when we give it to Him. When we do not do this it is pride, as we are essentially standing in the place of the Lord. What did Job learn when he went head to head against God trying to defend his case? **He learned that God was the potter and he was the clay and who was he to question God!**

So many times in my walk I have been hearing the words 'let go and let God'. This means in all things – not just some. We have to take our hands off ourselves, our lives and our circumstances in order for God to be able to do it for us. This is another example of where we must learn to let go. We are not supposed to defend, argue or plead our cause before God. We have to learn to take a step back and allow Jesus into these situations, who can then plead our cause before God for us, and can then lead and guide us into victory through direction from His Holy Spirit. Trust is the ultimate thing that God is teaching every one of us to enter into. How can we let go and allow Jesus to plead our cause for us? Easy – first we repent for pleading our own cause and then let go and hand it over to Jesus. Second we spend time praying in tongues as this allows the Holy Spirit to make intercession for us. *(I had seen lots of teaching lately to pray in tongues but for some reason I kept resisting always finding myself distracted and unable to do it. I now knew that the enemy was causing me to resist praying in tongues and this is of utmost importance and something we all need to do – frequently - in order to allow the Holy Spirit who stands in the place of Jesus within us, into our lives and circumstances).* **Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them (Hebrews 7:25, NKJV).**

(PRAYER) – “Father God I repent for each time I have tried to plead my own cause. This is pride and takes from the role of Jesus and the Holy Spirit who works on my behalf. It also shows lack of trust in You and the inability to let go of control in order to hand it over to You. I ask You Lord Jesus to plead my cause and execute justice for me. Thank You Jesus that You are my advocate who is at the Father’s right hand interceding for the pardon of my sins. Thank You Holy Spirit for leading me to a deeper knowledge of the gospel, and giving me divine strength to enable me to undergo trials and persecutions on behalf of the Kingdom. You are the potter, I am the clay, I am sorry for questioning You!”

******Pray in tongues and do this as often as you can******

Assumption – I had been going through a health trial for around eight years, with the last five being the worst. God had promised me at the beginning of it that I would be healed of all the ailments that plagued me. This was confirmed by many other people through word of knowledge. When your promises tarry it can be torturous. You go through seasons of great faith, no faith, being hopeful, losing hope and on it goes. Recently I had some massive encounters with Jesus – one where I was enveloped in His light, seeing the light with my natural eyes whilst He spoke to me about the second infilling. I was shouting out ‘I surrender, I surrender to You’. Naturally I assumed that I had received the second infilling and would start the healing process and find myself changed in lots of areas. Two months after this encounter nothing had changed. Then I was shown Jesus’s hands outstretched coming from the doorway of our office and told to enter through, I did and when I did I heard the words; **“You have gone through the door! I am the door. What does this mean? No more blockages. Nothing unyielded. You have exchanged your life for My life.”** Again I naturally assumed I was done, I had made it and the blessings would start to manifest in my life. Instead everything got even worse. Upon asking the Lord why this had happened He told me I was about to enter my promised land and had to battle against the giants who were in there by using my sword (His word). I started reading out loud the words He gave me to pray every day and things still did not improve. I was feeling beaten down, losing hope and entering into depression.

I was recently at my in laws and we were talking about the great tribulation and the end times. I have noticed how they have 100% faith and trust in God whilst I still tend to view the world through eyes of fear. I was pondering this when the Lord spoke to me and this is what I heard, **“You are standing on a foundation of fear. Many see through the eyes of trust in God – you do not. You don’t know My love – things are about to change for you. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love (1 John 4:18, KJV). Love – the love of the Father. The natural world cannot give you the love, security and peace I can. There are so many blockages to receiving the love of God – not from My end, but from yours. Why are you standing on a foundation of fear? Lack of trust in God. If you knew My love you would fear not. You have felt My love, but you do not know My love. Knowing My love is receiving the fullness of the knowledge of My love in you. How do you receive My love? You let Me in. Many of My children build walls that don’t allow My love into them. You have such a wall, in fact you have several. Little Tania prevents adult Tania from trusting fully in Me. Little Tania self-protects at all costs. This wall was formed when your Dad left the family home when he and your mother divorced. Abandonment from the Father. Your security – the head of the home left. A huge void – a feeling of insecurity and vulnerability ensues. This wound has not yet been healed in you. When the head of the family leaves, the impact is great. You automatically fill the void through self-protection. You have to allow Me to protect you. Let down that wall of self-protection. What if I let you down? You want to be safe from all harm, danger and evil but while you are in the world there is tribulation. The word of God says that I have overcome the world. If you let Me, what the world says is trouble I can turn to good. Trust Me and I**

will do this always. Can you trust Me to do this?" I replied "Yes". He spoke again, "Do not fear the tribulation – rejoice that I will turn it for good. Instead of looking at the tribulation focus on My outcome. Can you do that? Always ask Me to show you the end results in all tests and trials. Look for Me. I understand you are having trouble seeing I am good because I promised you healing and it has not come yet. I see your suffering and see how hard it is at times for you to continue to stand. I have strengthened you so that you are able to continue to stand. Now it is time to receive the promise – the fulfilment of what I told you would happen. You will be well in your body and you will be enshrouded in love, joy and peace. People will want what you have. Instead of simply telling them to trust as others have done to you, you will be able to take them through the steps and show them what has to be done to achieve it. There are reasons why people cannot easily break free from those things that ail them.

Your ministry dismantles those strong holds in people's lives so they can be set free. The end goal for you is to be filled with My Holy Spirit with love, joy and peace in your soul. This is the second infilling where the soul (mind, will, emotions, and conscience) is made new. People need to be made whole in order to be able to receive the fullness of the power of God. This is not just for your own well-being, but also so you can carry the fullness of My anointing to heal others. Forgive those who criticise you for your fears and lack of faith. They don't mean to hurt or condemn you. Their misunderstanding of how some are not standing on the foundation of love means they can never be in your shoes or have the understanding to be so. You will never fully understand them and they will never fully understand you. Other people are in the same shoes as you – your Ministry is for them. I will use your suffering and pain for good by using you to help those who can't be helped by one who has not walked this path and learned how to conquer it through My keys of revelation knowledge.

Lack of love from the Father – the curse of anxiety, fear and worry and the ability to see only through the eyes of fear will be broken from you. I am teaching you to trust Me by showing you My heart, and by showing you the blockages. Although the healing tarries all is not lost – there is also healing in the tarrying as you gain revelation knowledge along the way. These are keys. Each revelation enables you to trust Me more. You get angry - I show you the reason why your healing is prolonged and you learn more of Me and My Kingdom and its ways. Although in principle you have laid down that wall it still has to become a reality. Actions have to back up our words. You are still laying down that wall, bit by bit, piece by piece as you get to know Me. Trust didn't come easy to you and I had to tread carefully. When that wall has collapsed that is when you will receive all of Me. You can't trust Me until I show you My love. Once you trust Me you can receive My love." Feeling confused I reminded God about my massive encounter when I saw the light of Jesus and was transported to Heavenly places and surrendered to Him, and also when I walked through the door and He told me I had exchanged my life for His life. He replied, "This was showing you the end. Has it happened yet? I know all and see all and this was Me showing you what is to come." I was a bit stunned when

God told me this and I felt rather annoyed. I truly had believed that during those encounters I was receiving what I needed in that moment and was surprised to learn that they were simply God showing me what the moment I receive will look like. To be honest in that moment I felt a bit like the person who is running after the finish line and the finish lines keeps moving further and further away. It seemed to me I get yet so close but still so far away.

The next day things were getting on top of me, it all became too much and I had another rant at God. I was having trouble sleeping due to palpitations, night sweats, muscle spasms, chest pain, reflux and adrenaline surges throughout the night, day time wasn't much better, and yet I was still ministering to other people in obedience to God which is difficult when you are not feeling well. I kept thinking about how God told me all those encounters I had previously experienced were a promise of what was to come and weren't actually the end result as they happened, and as I had believed. I felt really annoyed that I had believed they were the actual thing at the time (only to end up disappointed that nothing had changed) and God hadn't revealed to me until now that these encounters were depicting what was to come. They were promises of my original promise and now I was feeling a little ripped off. I stomped off to Mark and told him how hurt and disappointed I was. When I am feeling like this I want a sympathetic ear and need compassion, empathy and support, and someone to relate to and understand how I am feeling. I should have known better than to go to my husband for this. Mark and I are very different. I am very emotional and he is not. Instead of empathy and compassion I normally get corrective criticism from him - He sees a problem and simply wants to fix it proceeding to tell me all the things he believes I am doing or believing wrongly. In this instance when I expressed my annoyance and hurt with the situation He replied "Well you do have knee jerk reactions and react out of your assumption of what you believe should or is happening". Well that went down like a lead balloon which ended up with me even angrier and now in tears telling Mark that most people would assume the same thing, especially when having a mighty encounter with Jesus in His presence and even more so when He is speaking to you like it **is** the end result. I was angry with Mark and God for quite a while. I sat in my room for some time in an attempt to calm down. Once I had calmed down I heard God say "**Are you ready to hear Me now?**" I replied "Yes". He spoke, "**Have you ever prayed and asked Me to show you the end result through your trials? Have you ever prayed and asked to see the situation through My eyes?**" "Yes" I answered I had prayed both those things quite a few times.

He replied, "**Well that is what I was doing, I was answering your prayers**". Well that made me even madder. I replied "Why didn't you tell me that was what You were doing instead of allowing me to believe I was actually in that moment receiving those things. It would have saved a lot of heartache and angst. I sat pondering for a while and slowly started seeing this through God's eyes. He was right, I had asked for Him to show me the end result of my suffering, and for Him to show me situations through His eyes. He had delivered exactly what I asked for in a mighty and spectacular way (I just didn't realise it at the time). He reminded me of how mad I had been at Mark and spoke again, "**I need you to repent for being self-centred and expecting others to supply your needs. Forgive them for being unable to**

do so." I then realised it was my own expectation of what I needed from Mark that was the problem. Could he have handled it better? Yes, but this was his way of dealing with things and our ways are not the same. I said sorry to Mark for getting so angry because he didn't say what I wanted to hear. I also repented to God for being self-centred and expecting others to supply my needs. Mark also felt led to pray to God and asked Him to help him to remember to offer compassion and have empathy for situations when I am hurting, before he offers corrective advice. As I got revelation of these things the Lord also spoke to me the word 'compromise'. People need to learn to compromise with each other as no two people are the same. They need to learn each other's needs and ask God to help them supply those needs. As people we are not God and only through Him can we help one another grow and supply what they actually need for healing, instead of giving or offering them what we think they need. We all need constructive criticism as it helps us learn but how we deliver that constructive criticism should always be through love, compassion and understanding. We need to ask God to help us love people more through His love and see the situation through His eyes rather than our own. Then and only then can we operate through a Kingdom mind-set rather than a worldly one.

(PRAYER) – "Father God in Jesus name I repent for assumption and wrong expectations. I am sorry for assuming any encounters I have had with you were the actual fulfilment of my promise, when they were the gift of faith in action. You were showing me without a doubt the fulfilment of my promise to help me continue to stand in faith and belief. Thank You for showing me this. I am sorry for blaming You and lashing out at You when my expectation or understanding of that encounter wasn't fulfilled how I expected it to be. I forgive all those who have condemned or criticised me for my faults. I repent for being self-centred and expecting other people to supply my needs in the way I needed. I forgive them for not supplying my needs. I repent also for not supplying the needs of another person in the way they needed. I ask that You would help me to love people through Your love. Help me to give corrective criticism in love, care, compassion and understanding through Your eyes, rather than through my eyes and the eyes of the world. I pray that You would please prepare the heart of the receiver to receive it. I again relinquish all false walls of protection and those things that prevent me from receiving Your love. I forgive all those who caused me to stand on a foundation of fear. As I go through trials and tribulations please help me to focus on You. Please continue to show me the end result to enable me to keep the faith until I receive my promise. I ask that You would continually show Me Your love so I can fully trust in You and receive the fullness of Your love. I step aside and allow You to protect me and I repent for standing in the way. In Jesus name, Amen."

Lay Down Your Plans – I am a meticulous planner. I plan everything. If I don't plan left, right and centre for my life then I feel completely out of control and out of my depth. I even plan my weekly grocery shop around the meals I will prepare for that week by planning a week in advance what our meals will be for the entire week. I write lists and my week of plans of daily activities in advance. I even have a list of what job of housework I will do each day. I am not spontaneous in any shape or form and have a need to control my environment and circumstances in order to feel safe

and secure. All my friends and acquaintances have been told that if they want to visit they need to let me know in advance as people turning up unannounced puts me in a tail-spin and panic. I have to have my house in order for visitors as well as be ready and presentable in myself. Living like this is hard but it does have its rewards – meticulous planners are usually perfectionists and have high standards. Maintain a high efficiency and usually a polished result but of course it does come at a cost. Things like going away for holidays is a real mission for me as it is out of my routine and comfort zone which means I have to plan every last detail and spend most of my time worrying I will forget to do something.

Recently a friend of mine had a vision about me and she emailed me what she saw. God showed her that I was about to get on a train with a suitcase, but He told me to leave the suitcase behind and get on without it, and trust Him. I found out that trains represent moving from one place to another and He told me that the suitcase represented my needs and I was not to worry, and that He would supply all my needs.

One of my greatest needs is to be healed of the anxiety disorder, fear and panic that I have suffered with my entire life. Many years earlier God had told me that I wasn't able to receive His healing from this disorder because I didn't trust Him. He told me that not trusting Him was a blockage and was preventing me from receiving His perfect love which casts out fear. He told me that He was taking me on a journey of teaching me about Himself and revealing His love for me so I could learn to trust Him, and when I trusted Him I would receive His love and healing from this disorder. Since entering menopause, as I go through the transition the fluctuating hormones have tricked my body into believing there is a threat, so as a result I have been stuck in flight or fight for five years with no reprieve from the relenting symptoms. This means my sympathetic nervous system is always switched on to full day in and day out with no calm or peace. Hot flashes, night sweats, heart palpitations, sore joints, tight muscles, irritable bowel – you name it - I seem to have it – all day, every day. I have tried everything I know to try and help but nothing has helped my situation. Experts say that when the transition comes to an end and the hormones settle into their new lower levels, the body will deactivate this switch as it no longer detects a threat and you can experience calm in your system again. The problem is this transition can take anywhere between one and ten years. When it first began I was so overwhelmed with what was happening to me I laid down ministering for two years as it was just too hard and the fear of what was happening to me caused even more panic and symptoms. As I studied and learnt more about menopause I was able to see that these symptoms (as awful as they are were not dangerous and wouldn't kill me). Last year the Lord spoke to me and told me 'If I started ministering again and trusted Him I would be healed as I was under the anointing praying for others'. It has been difficult but I was obedient and stepped out and did this and have done this ever since. Unfortunately I have still not yet received my healing, but because God gave me this word (which was confirmed by another minister) I have no reason to doubt but continue to press in and trust His process.

Recently I had a visit from a friend who also suffers anxiety and fear. She also suffered greatly from fear whilst driving, which is also one of the biggest causes of fear and panic for me. She told me that one day at home a few weeks back she had

experienced the presence of God's love all over her and through her and was healed instantly from her anxiety.

She told me that all fear while driving was gone – vanished, no more. As she was talking to me she discerned that there was still something unyielded that I hadn't surrendered to God. We asked the Holy Spirit what it was and she got the word 'helper' and saw me in a window on the top floor of a tall control tower. I believed God was showing me I still hadn't let go of control. My friend also saw me burying a cake in the garden. Not understanding fully what the Holy Spirit was showing us I assumed that He would reveal more to me at a later stage.

When I found out she was healed from anxiety I was really pleased for her but also quite sad for myself that I still was not healed from any of these things. I had been 100% obedient to the word God had given me so was feeling confused as to why I still hadn't received this healing. I spoke to my friend about how the biggest thing I struggled with in trusting God was that the Bible promises protection for those who believe and belong to Him, but it also promises suffering as part of our walk in Him, and I didn't know what suffering I still had to face and what He would allow, and that was where the source of the fear came from. I was also tormented by a foreboding spirit who would plague my imagination with detailed visions and thoughts of the worst case scenario in every situation I faced. I would try to tell myself that God would protect me and my family and not let these things that I was seeing in my imagination happen, but my heart at the same time truly didn't know how much we were protected from and could these things still happen as part of my walk of suffering as all in Christ still partake of His suffering. ***For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us (Romans 8:18, KJV).***

But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you (1 Peter 5:10, KJV). What would He protect us from and what wouldn't He? This is where my fear came from – the not knowing. People would tell me to trust that God was for me and not against me, and that He wouldn't let me suffer more than I could handle. They would say that He will turn all bad things to good and use them for His purpose. I knew all this but it didn't console me. I wanted to hear that nothing bad would ever happen to me and my family ever again. I didn't want bad things turned to good, I wanted no bad things ever! Living in fear of bad things and thinking worst case scenario with every situation you face is an awful way to live. My husband takes each day as it comes, thinks the best and says if the worst happens we will deal with it then. I was the opposite – I imagined and thought the worst all the time and lived in fear, worry and panic every day of my life. It was also hard for me to truly believe God was in control and could protect me supernaturally if something went wrong. This was one of the main reasons I planned everything. I super protected myself and my family from worst-case scenarios as best I could.

After my friend had left I approached God and asked Him why I still had not yet received my healing. He reminded me of the vision where I was to leave my suitcase behind. This is what I believe He spoke, ***“Leave the suitcase behind. Whatever you have planned and whatever you think you need lay them down and I will supply your needs. I have predestined a time for you to receive your***

healing. You will be healed above and beyond what you could ever ask or imagine. Time to start the next leg of your race. When you let go of control it will be the single best thing you can do. You are still hanging onto control – not wanting to let go. The truth is ‘you are not in control, I am’. I have everything in My hands – your whole life is in My hands. Planning everything yourself – this is what I need for you to let go of as this is not trusting in My provision for you. I come in and dismantle the best laid plans. Man likes to plan and be organised. Godly order is better than man-made order. When things don’t go the way you planned, rest in Me and trust the Holy Spirit who is your helper for direction. You don’t trust in My plans for your life. For I know the plans I have for you, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, to give you a future and a hope. You will experience a change of mind-set when you trust in My plans. It doesn’t mean I don’t want you to plan things – man needs order but if I choose to dismantle these plans rest in Me that My ways are above your ways. Go ahead with your plans and trust Me to change them when you give Me your plans. The key is to relinquish your plans and the things you do to keep yourself safe.”

He then reminded me of the following Scripture - ***For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope (Jeremiah 29:11, NLT).***” As I meditated on that Scripture in that instance a mind-set broke. I had seen that Scripture so often and even prayed it over other people but I never had before realised that it was a promise, an assurance from God that actually dismantles the foreboding mind-set of ‘what if’s’. I then took that Scripture back to the King James Version and this is what it says, ***For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.*** The word thoughts in Hebrew is **Machashabah** and means 1) thought, device 1a) thought 1b) device, plan, purpose 1c) invention. The word thinks in Hebrew is **Chashab** and means 1) to think, plan, esteem, calculate, invent, make a judgment, imagine, count.

If God promises His plans and purpose are to prosper you and not to harm you, and that His plans are for good and not for disaster to give you a future and a hope, then His promise is that any suffering He uses is for that purpose and that purpose alone. My fear of ‘what if’s’ could be broken by proclaiming this Scripture every time the fear comes. In the past I proclaimed fear Scriptures but the problem was my heart believed the ‘what if’ more than God’s goodness. God’s goodness is apparent in this Scripture – everything and anything He does is to prosper you and not harm you, and His plans are for good. I had to trust in the goodness of God and believe like my husband to ‘think the best’ and deal with anything if it comes. I then remembered something else that made my ‘what ifs’ more powerful than my trust in God. God once told me that if you are suffering anything ‘more’ than you can bear it is because the devil has legal rights over those areas, and the events are orchestrated by the devil and not God, and His hands are tied in those situations. An example of this is I once heard of a man who was a Christian and his young daughter was raped and murdered. God took him on a journey of forgiveness. He eventually forgave the man and was blessed but his road to receiving this blessing was incredibly rough. The Lord revealed to me that the open door to this happening was the fact that he had murdered his father. When he was a child his father used to beat him, and in retaliation he murdered his father. The Bible is clear that you reap what you sow.

What happened to his daughter was from the consequences of what he had sown as the flow on effect gets passed down. The key to removing these open doors for the devil to orchestrate his plans over your life is to always enter into the will of God, stay close to God and keep an intimate relationship with Jesus and ask the Holy Spirit to show you how to remove all things that are blockages to you, which prevent you and your descendants from receiving all the blessings Jesus has inherited for you. We are then able to confess and turn away from these sins and God can close the door on any plans that the devil is trying to orchestrate in your life. When you are in the will of God you enter into His plans for you and these plans are good and not for disaster. We need to be completely under the shelter of His wings in all areas of our life. The more of your life you lay down, the more of His resurrection life you gain. You are raised in resurrection life as you and Jesus put to death the old man. So many people are not taught about the reaping and sowing effect. Every action has a consequence – good or bad and it is so important to ask the Holy Spirit to reveal sin in your life so that these negative effects can be cancelled before they turn into an opportunity for the devil. **For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life (Galatians 6:8, NKJV).**

I then realised that planning everything yourself without first handing over your plans to God was taking His plans for you out of the equation. We have to lay down our plans and enter into His. **Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans (Proverbs 16:3, NIV).** We also need to trust God when things don't go according to our plans. If it ever happens we need to stop, pray and listen. I believe it is a good practice to give your plans to Jesus every day. Hand them over and ask the Holy Spirit (our helper) to lead and guide us into His plans for us. God wants to be involved in every part of our lives. By handing over our plans to Him each day we are also asking Him to be part of our decision making process. We need for Him each day to go ahead of us and prepare the way. What steps and plans are we making each day to serve and protect ourselves? It is not wrong to do this as the Bible says to use wisdom but if we are taking control from God because we are trusting more in ourselves than Him we are entering into our own plans for our lives and not His. If we are not giving our plans daily to God how can we expect His perfect plan for our lives to prevail? We are trying in our own strength to do things our way and without Him. I then realised that planning everything and not giving this to God was a huge part of me wanting to always be in control. I was making plans and not asking God to make them with me. I was doing it alone and it was all to do with self-protection. When you hand your entire life over to God (including your plans) and there is something ahead that is not going to prosper you then trust that God will remove it and not let it happen. I knew this truth was my key to breaking the power of the spirit of foreboding. God's plans are to prosper you, the devil's plans are to harm you. The key is to give your whole self to God so the devil can no longer have his hands on you. This includes your plans. I was holding back from God my trust in His plans. His word said that His plans for us are to prosper us and not to harm us. I was going ahead and planning my day which always included ways to keep myself and my family safe. I was now going to make a conscious effort to pray each day and hand my plans over to God and trust that His plans were going to prosper us and not harm us. **A man's heart plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps (Proverbs 16:9, NKJV).**

The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way (Psalm 37:23, KJV).

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths (Proverbs 3:5-6, NKJV).

As I began writing this article I got a revelation for the visions of the cake and the control tower my friend saw. The control tower I was sitting in was where I placed myself to oversee everything. I had put myself in the place of God. When I bake a cake I always follow a recipe - this is what God was wanting me to surrender - my way of doing things which is based on planning which is why she saw me burying the cake. No longer my way but God's way. When I looked up what a cake meant in the Christian dream symbol book it said a cake was celebratory of a person's life. This meant too that I needed to lay down and bury my old life. He also revealed to me that He wanted me to stop reading and watching things that caused negativity and worry as that fuelled the foreboding spirit. The Bible tells us to meditate on things that are lovely and pure and pleasing to God. By resisting these things and turning away from them the spirit of foreboding won't have as much ammunition or power to yield over us. ***Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you (James 4:7, KJV).***

(PRAYER) – “Father God in Jesus name I repent for not surrendering my plans to You. I repent that I put my planning system ahead of Yours. More often than not I plan things as a means of self-protection, security and control which means I have put myself in the place of God. I repent for planning things alone and not asking You to plan them with me. I give You permission to dismantle every plan I have made that is not in accordance with Your plans for me. I repent for partnering with the foreboding spirit and for not believing Your truth that Your plans are to prosper me and not to harm me, and that they are for good and not for disaster, and to give me a future and a hope. I surrender my plans to You Lord Jesus Christ. I lay down every plan I have made and every plan I will make. I enter into Your perfect plan for my life. When things don't go according to my plans I ask that You would always remind me to stop, pray and trust in Your Holy Spirit who is my helper for direction. I repent for reading, listening and watching negative things that feeds the spirit of foreboding and fear with fuel to use against me. Please cleanse my eyegate and eargate from these things and replace them with the pure and holy things of God. Please remind me to submit my plans to You every day. Thank You Father, Son and Holy Spirit for the roles that You each have in my life. I submit to You as my one and only God, Lord and Saviour. I pray this in Jesus name, Amen.”

DAILY PRAYER – “**All that I do on this day Lord Jesus I commit unto You and ask that You would go ahead of me and establish my plans and direct my paths. Thank You, In Jesus name, Amen.**”

Justifying Yourself - How many times has other people's critique of you stopped you or hindered you from proceeding forward in your walk? What people say about us can really impact our lives in a negative or positive way. I have found the hardest judgments to take are from the ones who you believe know you, and who

understand the call of God over your life and who you believed understood and knew your heart. People's words and opinions can shut us down if we do not give everything to God and allow Him to show us how to handle the situation correctly.

Recently I was seriously contemplating laying down the call of God over my life as a result of receiving negative criticism. Negative words (even constructive criticism) hinders me greatly as I have a wound of 'never been good enough' and 'a need for approval'. I have talked in the past about how I have struggled with pride (always rebuking it) when God uses me for such amazing things. I have never made a secret of how I am always repenting to God for stealing His glory because I am enjoying the praise and attention I get from other people when I am operating under the anointing. People use words such as 'wow, your gifting's are amazing', or 'I wish I had gifting's like yours', or 'I am jealous of your relationship with God' which means you have to guard against pride and keep reminding them and yourself it is not 'you' but 'God in you'. My wound of being put down, ridiculed for being different and rejected from an early age laps up this attention.

In saying this though there are also times that I feel so humbled and honoured to be used in this way that I almost feel embarrassed and bad for others who are not being used in the same way and desperately want to be. Walking in the call of God is not easy and God uses things like persecution to humble us. In fact God has shown me that one of the reasons my healing for my ill-health has been taking so long is a direct result of Him protecting me from pride. He told me He is bringing me to a place of knowing that only through Him I can do what He is calling me to do. I am so filled with fear and anxiety from my past that I know when I am healed of this and can do things I normally cannot, it can only be Him because in my own strength it is impossible. This is what He spoke in regard to this: - ***"Pride. You were very prideful in the beginning – taking My glory for yourself. I have reduced you to such a place of weakness that you know My strengths resting upon you couldn't possibly be you. You desperately need Me and in this place of being strengthened you will be able to give Me all the glory and all the praise. Pride will not be able to gain a foothold because of how I outworked this in you. I am pruning you so I can use you for My glory. I did it this way because I was protecting you. I have always had your back and I always will. There will come a time where you will be so pleased I did it this way."***

When you are called by God to 'put yourself out there' and 'speak in His name' you are inevitably going to bring attention to yourself. With this comes good and bad attention. When I did things in His name and people responded favourably all was good, but when people started to talk and make judgements, some of which I knew not to be true, then it is not so good! I told God I didn't think I was strong enough to handle persecution, and the judgments of other people. In tears before writing this article I asked Him what to do. The way I was feeling was that I simply wanted to fade into the background and no longer put myself out there – it sometimes is just too hard. In that moment of telling God this, He showed me that I was basing doing His works on the feedback. If it was good then I was willing to proceed, but now because I had received critique (over the course of a couple of weeks) and I felt wounded I was contemplating not doing His works anymore. He told me that doing works for Him should always be about pleasing Him and not man. He showed me that my need for approval was being met when He used me greatly because of the

praise and attention from those around me, but now that there was judgement and criticism aimed toward me I wanted to run.

I had a decision to make – do I pick myself up and keep doing as God has asked me knowing I have to continue to walk in the judgements and opinions of others or lay it all down and hide? He then proceeded to tell me that in order to survive this I needed to understand ‘being justified by Christ’. Interestingly I had been told recently that I had to stop trying to explain and justify myself to people all the time. I never until now understood why that was a bad thing for me to do so I decided to see what the Bible says about self-justification? ***If I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me: if I say, I am perfect, it shall also prove me perverse (Job 9:20, KJV).*** The word justify here in Hebrew is **Tsadaq** and means clear ourselves, make to appear righteous and vindicate the cause of.

And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God (Luke 16:15, KJV).

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Romans 5:1-2, KJV). The word of God tells us that we are justified by faith in Jesus Christ.

Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him (Romans 5:9, KJV). His blood justifies us. What does the word justified mean in this passage? In Greek the word is **Dikaioo** and means to declare, pronounce, one to be just, righteous, or such as he ought to be. We are made righteous in the eyes of God through the Blood of Jesus by having faith in Him.

The Lord God then spoke to me and this is what I heard, ***“As you walk with Me you will suffer persecution. Jesus did, then so will you. How you handle it is the key. Will you walk away or will you rise above? Are you supposed to plead your own cause and justify yourself before men? Let Jesus do it for you. Some see through the eyes of the flesh and make judgments against you. Hand them to Me. Forgive them and let Me show them ‘you’ through My eyes. You are justified through faith in Jesus. You are made right before Me through the Blood of Jesus. Self-justification is you putting yourself above God. It is you saying you are better than the Blood of Jesus who has already justified you in the eyes of God. If you are justified in My eyes why do you need to be justified in the eyes of man. Do you put man above God? Man will always judge. Do not worry what another thinks of you – worry only what I think of you. Do My will and walk My path. You are there to help another to walk also on My path. Take what is said and learn from it. Correcting one another in love when one is walking contrary to the will of God to guide them away from sin is good. Although you are justified (made right in My sight), those who walk in the flesh still sow to the flesh which has adverse effects in their life and circumstances. Leading and guiding someone away from this is good but self-justification is not. If someone has an opinion of you that is not good let them come to you in love to correct. Take on board what they have to say and if you disagree with anything being said thank them and tell them you will pray about***

it. This is all you need to do. If you are willing to repent and change those things that are not pleasing to Me then I will help you do it. If you are being accused of something that is not right then I will vindicate you. Let go and let God. How you handle things determines how far in God you go. Don't let offences become a stumbling block – rather let them become a stepping stone into the future things of God.”

(PRAYER) – “Father God in Jesus name I forgive and bless all those who have persecuted, judged and corrected me and all those who have formed wrong opinions of me. I hand them over to You Lord Jesus and ask You to show them ‘me’ through Your eyes. I repent for all the times I have judged, persecuted and corrected another and formed wrong opinions of them. Please show me ‘them’ through Your eyes. Please help us all to discern through the Holy Spirit rather than through our flesh. Thank You for all the times You have used others to teach me things. I repent for all the times I have rejected these things. I repent for dictating the terms and conditions in how I want to work for You. I choose to work for You regardless of whether I receive good, bad or no attention. I am sorry also for the times I have tried to justify myself and put myself above the Blood of Jesus. I was justified in the Blood of Jesus by faith in Christ the day I was saved, which means I am made right in the eyes of God so I need not justify myself before man. I am justified in Your sight which means I do not need to be perfect in the eyes of man. Help me to remember to always do the right thing when faced with persecution, judgment and correction against me. I pray for healing of all wounds caused through these things in Jesus name. Thank You, Amen.”

Surrender To The Call Of God – *But as God hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk. And so ordain I in all churches (1 Corinthians 7:17, AKJV).*

As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen (1 Peter 4:10-11, AKJV).

And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him (Luke 5:11, AKJV).

Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest (Luke 10:2, AKJV).

Recently I wrote a prayer and revelation about removing the graveclothes. In this I asked God what I still had to lay down before the graveclothes could be cut from me. He answered me a few days later and this is what I believe He spoke; ***“You asked me what you had to lay down? It was yourself for My call and purposes. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable***

service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God (Romans 12:1-2, KJV). I have been testing your commitment to the Ministry. Do you believe in My promises even though they tarry? The fruit from your Ministry was little. This was to test your faith and prevent pride until you were fully yielded and made new in your soulish areas. Your commitment has been great. Even in your weakness you were willing to be My vessel. Even when I didn't heal you, you continued. The call of God was placed within you. Many lay it down when the troubles come. You did not. That was all you and your choice. I couldn't make that choice for you. True surrender to the call of God. You believed in Me and you believed in the Son.

You believed Him at His word and persevered even though you didn't see the fruits of your labour. If you got fruit straight away pride would enter and take you out of the race. I have taught you to be careful. I have taught you to test everything. Donald Trump is about to win - the results will be overturned. My justice will prevail. This is for My purpose. My saints are about to rise up alongside Trump and they will rise up in power and be glorified. The fruits of your labour will be apparent. Life as you know it is about to change. You will have a face to face encounter with Me that will change your life forever. You will teach others how to surrender their lives, spirits, souls and bodies to Me. It is about the call of God over your life. The call of God should be above and beyond in importance than anything else. It is your commitment to serve Me and put Me first in your life. Walking in the calling of God should come above your families, your jobs, and your health. Sometimes when you are struggling in your health I will ask you to continue, other times I will advise you to rest. It is about listening to Me and My direction. Putting Me first above all else. It is obedience to Me in all facets of your life. What am I saying? It is about seeking Me in all things and putting My will and purposes ahead of your own. I look for these ones. They are not perfect, far from it – but they are obedient – putting Me first above all things. When you seek first the Kingdom and His righteousness then everything else can be added unto you (Matthew 6:33). I have chosen you for your dedication and for your commitment to serve Me. Not all are willing to lay down their lives for My sake – My body, which is the Church. The Church is lost and I am looking to save it. I am choosing the ones who have been tried and tested through the fire of God and come out clean – set free and healed. These ones are going up a level in God. They will become leaders of My army – calling those who are lost, blind, deaf, crippled, maim and weak to wholeness. Being saved is more than just a free ticket to Heaven when you pass from this life to the Kingdom of God – it is being made whole, healed and delivered while you are still living on this earth. My children bring My Kingdom to earth and display My works within them – but before this can happen fully, one has to die to themselves and this world. The body of Christ as a whole is weak, feeble and failing. I am restoring them and bringing back to life that which is dead or dying. Dying to self – the process of sanctification. I cause those things not of Me to die but not many understand or know how to receive My resurrection power of life into their souls and physical bodies. Your Ministry teaches how to receive and rise up in My resurrection power to bring back to life that which is dead. I am going to use

you mightily – as long as you are willing there is no place, or nowhere that we cannot go and conquer and come out victorious. Be ready - for things are about to escalate in a way this world has never seen before.”

As I was writing this, God brought to mind the people who had the call, or knew the call and laid it down because they trusted more in themselves or their negative circumstances more than the promises of God. If God gives us a promise and things seem to be not working out that way, we have to not allow circumstances to steal what God has for us. Things like finances and poor health can make us want to lay everything down so we enter into comfort and comfortable things instead of trusting in God. The Bible teaches that the road to God is narrow. Humans want the easy way and the least painful way. Seek God in all things – sometimes He may advise us to lay things down in order to do a new thing, or even have a much needed rest, but more often than not He may be testing our commitment to the promise or call that He has given us, and wants us to continue in it – no matter how hard or painful that is. There were times in my health struggles where He said ‘rest’ and other times where He said ‘keep going out and ministering’. During these times, before and after were so hard, but during the ministry sessions things became easier because of the anointing. This is how I knew that I was meant to continue to do what I was called to do, even though it was incredibly hard.

There were other times where our finances dried up so much that we considered that I should lay down the call of God and ministering to go back to work (as Mark was already working from home in our computer business) but God always said ‘no’. How much do we trust His word? How much do we believe in Him to do what He promised? If things are uncomfortable when we choose God and His will and not the world, then be assured that when you put God first everything else will eventually come into place. It may not happen immediately but if God says it will happen, it will happen just as He promised. I have found that we can have mind-sets and ideas of how it should look, or how God should do it. More often than not God’s ways are truly unconventional and we have to continue to trust Him in the process. Until I got this word I had no idea God was testing my commitment to the calling and Ministry He placed in my life. Throughout the whole eleven years that I have been a Christian I have never doubted the call over my life. I have had to guard against people trying to control or take over or lead me in a wrong direction. The devil will use people (and usually the ones closest to you) to lead you off track.

Ask God what the calling and purpose is that He has given you to serve Him and keep it close to your heart. Hold onto it no matter what and allow Him to lead the way. Continuing in the call of God over these last eleven years (especially the last six) where I have been struggling so much with health issues has been very hard but I can see that the perseverance and refusal to let God and His will for my life go will soon pay off. The promises that He gave me at the beginning will soon come to pass. My healing will enable me to continue to serve God in the next phase of my life even better than I already have. In the next phase I believe that the world is going to get worse and we are going to need God even more than ever before. It is time to lay down ourselves and what we want in order for God to utilise and use us more. We need to be healed, whole and delivered with a testimony of the goodness of God to help those who don’t know Jesus, and to help those who do know Jesus

but don't know how to receive all He has for them. Our experiences will be worth more than their weight in gold.

(PRAYER) – “Father God in Jesus name I ask that You would show me clearly my call and purpose in You. I repent for anytime I have laid down the call of God over my life. I repent for anytime I trusted more in the world, my own flesh and what the world was saying more than what You were saying. I repent also for not putting the call of God, which is my service to You ahead of other things in my life. Thank You Jesus for the call of God You have placed upon me. I pray that You would help me to fulfil that call and purpose and to achieve everything You have predestined for me to do. Help me to stand fast in that purpose and never let it go. Equip me for all that I need for my call and purpose in You. Help me to put the call of God first in my life. The call of God is my service to You to bring about Your purposes in the world. I lay myself down afresh to You and Your purpose for me. I commit myself to Your cause. The labourers are few but Lord Jesus I am willing. I pray also that You would send forth labourers into the harvest. As I walk in this call I pray that You would empower me with more of Your gifts, talents, power and strength to fulfil all You have called me to do. I lay down my life for Your sake – which is Your body – the church. Help me to reach them. I pray that You would use me to save them, complete them and make them whole through Your power and precious Blood. Thank You Lord Jesus, Amen.”

“I Surrender” – What does the word surrender mean? According to Dictionary.com it is to ‘stop resisting to an opponent and submit to their authority’. As a follower of Christ our ultimate goal is to surrender our spirit, soul, body and entire lives to Christ. God wants to bring us to a place where we recognise our total need and dependence is on Christ and on Him alone. In our walk with Jesus we can carry many burdens. The Lord showed me that some burdens are from Him, whilst other burdens are our own which we place upon ourselves, and then there are other burdens which are from people who place them on us. When we enter into covenant with Christ we also enter into His suffering and we take on His burden which is light. The Lord once told me that the reason His burden is light is because it is shared. Partnership in Christ. As you enter into covenant with Christ you are entering into partnership with His load. His burden is for the Church – the body of Christ. The burden we carry from Him is for all those who God has chosen for us to reach. He puts this load on us. It is part of our intercessory gifting. When we receive this burden (which goes hand in hand with the call of God over our lives) we then share this load with Him and other believers – we all take on a portion of the load. ***Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2, NKJV).*** This is what He once spoke to me, ***“You have prayed and asked Me many times to take this suffering away. This tied My hands, do you know why? You feel the suffering of others. This is a gift you are carrying. Just like Paul I have given you a thorn in your flesh. This thorn is the burdens of others. You are empathetic, just like Jesus. Empathy is defined as a highly sensitive person who is in tune with another's needs. You are carrying the burdens of all those I have called you to set free in My name. The more souls you have been destined to reach the greater the burden you must carry. You asked Me to remove this from you but I could not, until you had outworked your purpose in Me. Do you know what your purpose is in Me? Isaiah 61. This is your calling.***

I had to put the burdens of others on you. You accepted when I asked you to be a living sacrifice for Me. Just as Christ carried your burdens I need for you to carry the burdens of others. Lay down your life for My sake. Lay down your life for others. By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren (1 John 3:16, NKJV).

Another thing He taught me about was entering into His rest. There is a difference between your rest and His rest. Your rest is where you cease from all your works. His rest is when you are raised up in His strength and might and enter into His works. You cannot enter His rest until you have entered your rest. This is where you cannot do it anymore and have no choice but to rest. BROKEN – He has to bring you to the end of yourself where you can no longer continue in your own strength. His strength can then be placed upon you.

I was recently ministering to a lady who was really struggling with areas of unworthiness and condemnation. No matter how much I assured her that she was judged righteous in the eyes of God through the blood of Christ she based her worth on her own works. She knew the truth in her head but her heart refused to accept it. She had a strong hold (a fortress) in her thinking and no matter how many times she learned the truth the devil would condemn her over and over with his lies. She would often ask me how to repent or turn away from this. I would always assure her with the truth and pray for healing in this area but to no avail. After a very long time of this going back and forth the Lord gave me a word for her that really excited me. This was the word, -***“Surrendering isn’t about getting rid of the burden yourself. That is the whole point. You can’t. It is greater than you. Surrendering to Me isn’t that you have to lay it down and get rid of this burden yourself – it is admitting it is too hard and you cannot do it without Me. Give this burden to Me. Admit it is greater than you and stop striving to remove it. Accept you cannot do it and leave the rest to Me. Don’t expect the result instantaneously – you need to be patient and wait for Me to remove it. In the meantime don’t focus on the problem, focus on the problem solver – Me”***

How many times have we strived to become perfect and sinless in our own strength? It is an impossible feat which is why Jesus came in the flesh in the first place, because it was too hard for us. God first seeks to unearth our strengths and weaknesses through a series of trials and tribulations so He can recreate a ‘new you’. He brings out the best in us, and also the worst in us and brings us to a place where we have no choice but to surrender so we can be raised up in newness of life and strength – our own strengths and His strengths in our areas of weakness.

Just this morning as I was feeling overwhelmed and so very weak in my physical body He asked me this question ***“Tania why is the load I have put upon you so heavy when the burden is meant to be light because it should be shared between Me, you and other believers?”*** I answered, “I do not know.” He replied “There is not enough in the body of Christ doing My works. ***Then He said to them, “The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest (Luke 10:2, NKJV). There is very few people doing what you are doing. You are anointed by Me and others see that anointing so they run to you. There is only one of you and many of them. I am now calling you out to teach and train others in the Healing***

and Deliverance Ministry. I want you to raise up teams of people who will operate under the anointing I have given to you and do what you are doing. The load which is the burdens of all those I have called you to set free is broken by My anointing. I am bringing forth teams who will operate under the leading of My Holy Spirit listening to the voice of God ministering as you teach them. I need to make you well so you are strong in My might and in My power to do what I have called you to do. Time to lay down ministering and time to teach. I will open the doors to enable you to do this. Lay down Skype Ministry. This is no more. Continue to work with the teams of people whom you are currently working with. Your role is to guide, teach and train all I have taught you. Continue to lead in those sessions eventually allowing others to take that role. I am raising up leaders who can take your position. I will show you the ones who are to lead and you must give them the reins to oversee the session accordingly. Some are called to lead whilst others are called to assist alongside, allowing themselves to come under the authority of the leader. In this type of Team Ministry there needs to be one at the helm overseeing the general direction or flow of the Ministry session. This person needs to be adept at hearing and discerning the voice the voice of God. Leaders need to encourage their team member's participation throughout the session being careful not to take over the roles of the team members."

I then remembered how God had told me over a year ago that He wanted me to work with less structure and how there were times I was ministering with other people and how we all just flowed and bounced off one another in a spontaneous manner with no preparation beforehand or anyone leading, whilst other times I led a session in a more structured fashion (although a lot less structured than the old Ministry I was once doing where I added many checklists instead of relying on the Holy Spirit). Because of this conflict of operating in two different ways and how they both worked well I always pondered whether I was doing the right thing when leading sessions in a more structured fashion. I now asked Him to give me any insight or clarity on this as He had just told me in this word to teach in this more structured fashion. This is what I heard, ***"In a highly anointed group there often needs no one in control leading the proceedings as I can flow in them using their gifts in a spontaneous fashion. These ones can be used by God anywhere at any time and can flow in with others of like-mindedness. In regard to training ones who are learning to operate in Healing and Deliverance they need guidance and one to oversee."***

It is time for Jesus to take our heavy loads. Our own burdens and the burden He has also bestowed upon us. After He has finished outworking what is needed He will take our load that was given to us by Him and share it between Himself (by giving us His strengths) and sharing it with others so there will be more people operating under the same anointing. He will raise up others who can share your load with you by taking on a portion of the burden. He was now inviting me to lay down those burdens that I had put on myself and to also lay down that burden He had put upon me. I no longer had to carry this heavy load myself. Not only this, as I laid down my load God could put a share of this load and His Spirit (which is the strength and anointing to break the yoke) on those whom He had called to be raised up alongside me. Interestingly I had received an email from a friend (before I got this word) which backed up exactly what the Lord was speaking to me today. She had just read my

prayer and revelation called 'Birthing the New You' and remembered the story of Moses and how he was called to lead the people and carry the burden of the calling God had anointed him into. The burden became too much and he asked God how he could handle them all? God told him to appoint other leaders to help and God would take a portion of the Spirit he had placed on Moses and transfer it to them. I had never noticed this in the story of Moses before so was unaware of it, but God had already confirmed this word with Scripture to my friend before I had even received this word. God is so very good!

(PRAYER) – “Father God in Jesus name I surrender all. I give to You my life, spirit, soul and body. I lay down on the altar of God all My burdens. I forgive those who have placed burdens on me. I give to You those burdens I carry that I have picked up along the way that are weighing me down. I cast my cares upon You Lord Jesus. I now lay down the burden You have given me and declare that I cannot carry this burden by myself. It is too heavy, it is too hard and I need You to help me. I ask that You would lighten this load by strengthening those areas within in me that are weak by Your Spirit. I ask also that You would share this burden alongside a portion of Your Spirit, which is the anointing You have given Me, with those whom You have called to be raised up alongside me. The word of God says ‘Freely as you have received, freely give’. I surrender my portion and all You have given me and freely give it to others whom You have chosen to receive from You. Help me to raise up and teach those whom You have prepared for me into all that You require them to be. I ask also by your Holy Spirit that You would show me the things I am involved in that are weighing me down in which I need to lay down. In Jesus name I pray, Amen.”

Post Deliverance Infilling Prayer - “I break every curse over my life from preconception to the present day in the name of Jesus Christ. I ask Father God that every curse would be replaced with a blessing. In the name of Jesus and by the stripes He bore on His body I pray for healing within every area of my spirit/soul and body. (*Pray specifically for all ailments*). I command all misalignments to come into divine order in Jesus name. I cast out the spirit of infirmity in Jesus name. I cast out fear, shock and trauma in Jesus name. I command every fibre, every cell and every part of this body to come into divine order. I command all pain to leave in Jesus name. I pray for a creative miracle in all areas where body matter needs to be regenerated. I command all cells, cell structure, DNA, RNA, and all parts of the spirit/soul and body not to remember all traumas in Jesus name. I pray for the fire of God to burn off all remaining remnants and dross in Jesus name. I command every demon who has access to me to leave immediately in Jesus name. With the blood of the lamb I seal all doorways closed to the demonic and declare that demons can only exit and not re-enter. I bind the demonic doorkeepers and terminate their assignment against me in Jesus name. I ask for the Holy Spirit to infill with light all areas that were once dark in Jesus name. I pray for a hedge of protection to be placed around me and for any holes to be repaired in Jesus name. Thank You Father God in Jesus name for delivering me”.
