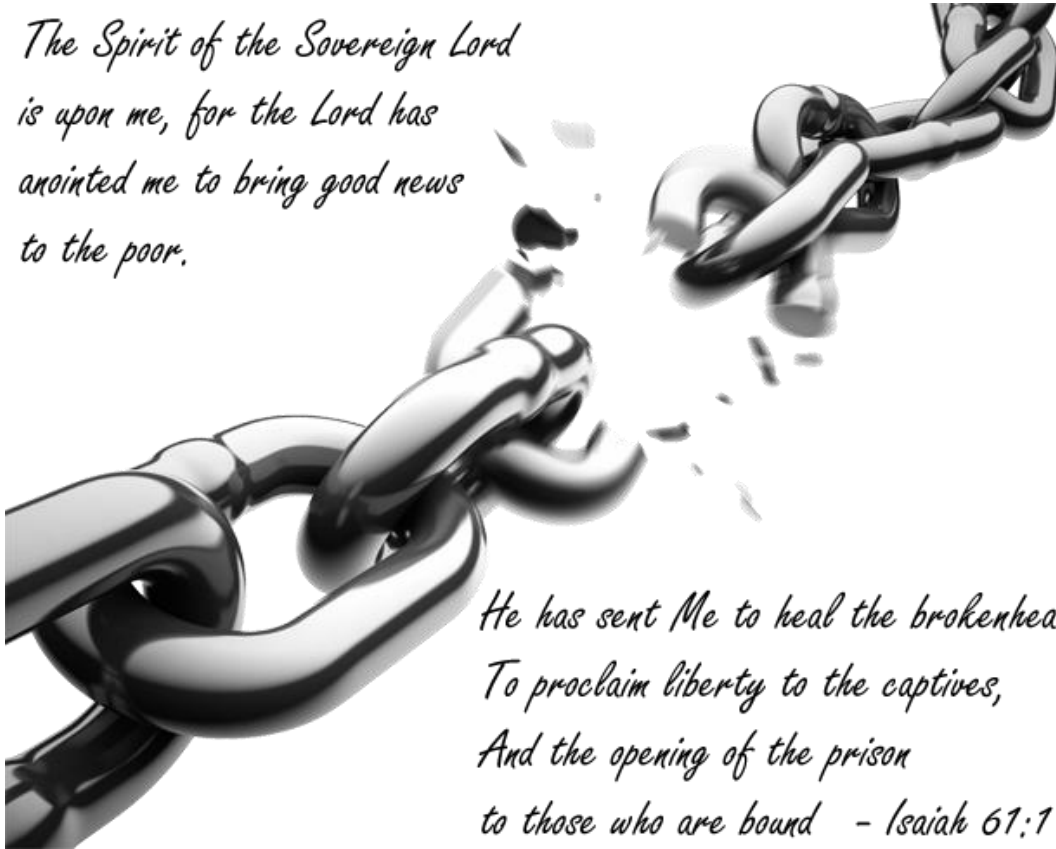


'His Timing'

Inner Healing and Deliverance Prayers

*The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord
is upon me, for the Lord has
anointed me to bring good news
to the poor.*



*He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to the captives,
And the opening of the prison
to those who are bound - Isaiah 61:1*

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*******Most of the prayers in this PDF are unique and not a replica of other people's ideas ~ they are created through revelation of the Holy Spirit and our view of what He has shown us as He works with us. There may be the odd prayer or idea that has been added to our Ministry from others because it impacted us, but more often than not you will be viewing an original.***

All prayers are subject to change as God gives new insight and revelation. All prayers are to be prayed out loud. Often you will see we ask you to do a prophetic act. A prophetic act is an action of obedience as a step of faith in the natural (physical) realm that supports God's workings in the spiritual realm, to release the power, presence and victory of God into a situation.

Prayer Of Protection: “Father God in the name of Jesus Christ and by the Power of Your Holy Spirit I pray that You would guide me through this journey of deliverance and healing. I thank You for the presence of the Holy Spirit.

I ask for Your protection, and that I am covered with the Blood of Jesus Christ. I also pray this protection over my loved ones, our pets, our belongings and our surroundings.

With the authority given to me by the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I bind you Satan, all demons and any other agents of Satan, my own human flesh which is antichrist, from any harm or attacks targeting me, my family, our homes and properties, our pets and belongings, our health and our finances, our businesses and our ministries.

I also bind you from any interference, distraction, transference, or blocking or counterfeiting the Holy Spirit, in Jesus name. I bind up and forbid any counterfeit gifts, un-godly manifestations, and lying signs and wonders, in Jesus name.

Father God, I thank You for Your heavenly angels and pray that they would be released in accordance with Your word.”

Please Note - Many of our prayers as an added precaution will include the term ‘ancestors’ to cover any sins that they may have participated in that you are unaware of.

Praise The Lord For His Timing – God’s timing is always perfect. If we try to rush God by running ahead to fulfil His promises in our timing it will never work out for us the way we want it to. We have to learn to wait on Him. This is not an easy feat for mankind. All so often I have been disappointed, disillusioned, and full of doubt because of how long His promises take to come to pass. “Will it really happen?” “Was I fooled?” “Am I believing a lie?” These are all examples of things the enemy speaks into our thoughts as we battle with impatience whilst waiting for God to move. ‘If God says He will do it, then He will do it!’ We need to stand on this truth no matter what. Ask God to give you faith in His promises while you are waiting – pray to receive the gift of faith to enable you to believe so you can keep hanging on to them. Ask also for endurance and tenacity so you may never let go of God and His promises. So many can give up while waiting because it is too hard. They may believe the lie that it is never going to happen and become so disillusioned they let go of and lose sight of God. So many times I am aware of being in a place where you find yourself drifting further and further from God because of disappointment. We have to guard against this.

As I was waiting for the promises of God to come I again felt saddened and full of doubt. During that time I got sent a word from a well know prophetess of God and she said in her prophetic word that ‘His timing is perfect and we need to offer a declaration of praise and trust in God that His timing is perfect’. It really struck me that I had lost sight of this and had again become entrapped in hopelessness, despair and doubt that I would ever receive the promise of healing in my life that was promised by God to me. As I was pondering what she wrote I immediately sensed that God wanted to give me a word about His timing to add to my ‘Inner Healing and Deliverance’ PDF’s and to our website. I sat before the Lord Jesus and asked what

was on His heart and immediately received a vision of a key. This is that I believe He spoke ~ ***“The key unlocks the door. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven (Matthew 16:19, KJV). The key represents revelation knowledge and those things I have taught you about removing the blockages that prevent you from receiving the love of God and all I have for you. Not trusting in My timing is one of those things. I am the door and behind the door is great pasture. I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture (John 10:9, KJV). The pasture represents My provision and blessings. Before you can receive the blessings you first have to unlock the door. The door is Me and the key unlocks the door to My heart. I give you the keys and in order for you to enter through the door you have to unlock the door and enter in. The key to receiving My heart is through surrender. You have to in turn offer your heart to Me. A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh (Ezekiel 36:26, KJV). An exchange happens at the cross - My life for your life. He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it (Matthew 10:39, NKJV). To gain My life means you have to lose your life. If you want to inherit all I have for you whilst living in this world you have to die to your old life through the dying to self-process. It is not instantaneous the moment you are born-again. Although My sacrifice is a gift from God to you, there is still a cost. To accept My gift you also have to be willing to accept Me. This means that you have to lay down your life for My sake. Lay down your life for My sake. Lay down your life for others. By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren (1 John 3:16, NKJV). It is about sacrifice. Yours and Mine. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God (Romans 12:1-2, NKJV).***

*It is taught today that My life given to you is a free gift given by God and that you don't need to do anything in return. Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life (Romans 5:18, KJV). It is correct that My life is freely given to you. This is a gift that I freely give. I laid down My life for you. You are declared free from guilt and acceptable to God through believing in Christ, but to declare that you are done and no more work is needed on your behalf is deception and one of the reasons many turn away, because when it comes to the refining, it becomes too hard as they do not understand the sacrifice and what it costs to become like Me. There is a cost and that cost is to lose your life for My sake. In losing your life there is a greater gain that is far greater than the loss. You gain Me, you gain life, you inherit the Kingdom. All these things however are not automatic. When you accept Me you do not gain the world, you have to let go of this world to gain the Kingdom. Much of the world is in your flesh and the flesh needs to be laid down so it can be raised in newness of life. **“But***

seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you” (Matthew 6:33). Let go of the world first. This is a requirement. It is actually very simple but it is lost in the current ‘grace’ teachings. If you physically died the moment you believed on Me and accepted Me as your Lord and Saviour you would inherit the Kingdom upon your death because you are justified and saved through grace, but while you are still alive and living in the world there is a sanctification process to go through before you can inherit the Kingdom on earth. You bring Heaven to earth as the world is removed from you. Flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God. Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption (1 Corinthians 15:50, KJV).

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God (John 3:5, KJV). To be born of water represents being washed in the water by the word of God. You bathe in His truth and be renewed by His Spirit. People expect everything overnight but it does not happen this way. My timing is perfect. My timing is when I deem you are ready – when I have done the work in you. I never expect you to do it alone, I am there every step of the way. You just need to be listening and be obedient to My promptings. When you fall I lift you back up – you just need to let Me. Pride and wanting to do it yourself is simply another blockage that needs to be outworked in you. You need to be able to submit your entire lives to Me and it takes a lot for one to fully relinquish all control to Me. It requires trust and trusting fully in Me is a great work that I have to do through all of My children. My timing is perfect and My timing has your best interest at heart, so that you can do all I have predestined for you to do. Many do not understand this and fight Me all the way. If they could see all that I see they would understand. Why then do I not show them everything through My eyes at the beginning? It would be too great for them to comprehend. Instead of helping them, it would hinder them. Why? Because to get to that place I am taking you takes great sacrifice and many would not be willing to sacrifice that much, so soon at the beginning, which could cause them to walk away. Humanness cannot comprehend the things of God but I can unpack them slowly over time so that you can adjust to My ways little by little. My ways are not your ways and it takes time to learn My ways and abide by them. This is accomplished by the renewing of your mind. To lose sight of My promises means you are not trusting in My timing which is equivalent to not trusting in Me. It is time to trust Me again. It is time for you to receive all I have promised you. Don’t let the enemy steal from you what I have for you. To receive these promises all you have to do is believe again. How, when you are so disappointed? Repent for lack of trust in Me and I again will fill you with faith to believe. It really is that simple. Repentance is your way of admitting you can’t do it without Me.

I need for you to be vulnerable to Me so that I can raise up My mighty arm of strength to do through you what I need to do. As you repent it is humbling and enables Me to work on your behalf. The whole reason why you have to wait is actually very simple – it is so I can prepare you to bring out the very best in you.” And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise (Hebrews 6:15, KJV).

But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint (Isaiah 40:31, KJV). “After you have endured through longsuffering you receive the promise.” (The word for longsuffering in Greek is **Makrothumia** and means patience, endurance, steadfastness). You suffer with Christ before you can be glorified in Him. It is part of going through the cross with Him. All must go through the cross. Christ is the door and is now on the other side of the Cross as He has already been through the cross. To go through the door (which is Christ) you need to first go through the cross. ***Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin (Romans 6:3-7, KJV).***

And he said to them all, if any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it (Luke 9:23-24, KJV).

And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together (Romans 8:17, KJV). It is all part of the walk. The road to God is narrow and great is the way to destruction (**Matthew 7:13-14**). It is not a punishment, it is chastisement. The word of God says that God chastises and scourges those whom He loves. ***As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent (Revelation 3:19, KJV).***

But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world (1 Corinthians 11:32, KJV).

He continued, ***“It is also about My timing and when I need for you to be ready. Not only is My timing about when you are ready, My timing is also about when I need for you to be ready. A mighty move of God is coming to those who are ready because I am ready to move. Are you ready?”***

(PRAYER) – “Father God I repent for not trusting in Your timing. Thank You that You have kept me on the narrow path which is the way to God. Thank You that You have disciplined, chastised and scourged me to get the very best from me, and that I will not be condemned with the world. I am sorry that I resisted Your ways. Your timing is perfect. I offer to You a sacrifice of praise for Your perfect timing and for Your perfect ways. Thank You that as I go through the cross, I will enter through the door, which is Christ and Who is on the other side of the cross, and as I go in and out, I will find an oasis of blessing and abundance that Christ obtained for me. I exchange my life for the life of Christ. I pray Lord God that I am ready for Your move that is about to come, and if I am not ready then I ask You Lord Jesus to make me ready. I again offer a sacrifice of praise for Your perfect timing, In Jesus name, Amen.”

Seek His Heart – In 2009 I was born again and filled with the Holy Spirit. I had a salvation experience that was supernatural, life changing and absolutely spectacular. I came from a non-Christian background. I had no clue that Jesus was God and that He came to save me. I married Mark and his parents were Christians. I would occasionally ask Rodney and Jean (Mark's parents) questions about God. I asked them how I could find God for myself and they told me to ask Jesus into my heart. Knowing nothing about Jesus except that He was the guy that was crucified on a cross (as I had watched a movie when I was younger) I asked Him into my heart. Soon after I was filled with the Holy Spirit completely out of the blue whilst sitting on my toilet at home. This was when I met Jesus and His Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit pointed me to the Bible and it was then that I learned all about Jesus and what He was to me.

About six months after this, feeling special and important because of how God had revealed Himself to me I asked Him if I came from the line of David. My thinking was that I must have had an important bloodline to be saved in such an impacting way. Jesus answered and this is what He said – ***“Tania your ancestors were Pharisees and they killed me.”*** Well that was shocking and removed any pride I had. Not long after, one day I was worshipping and singing when I had a vision of Jesus being crucified. In that moment God laid the sin of my ancestors on me. I started sobbing hysterically and yelling out that I was sorry. I literally felt like I had killed Him and that I had truly been part of it. For a long time I wept and wept and said I was sorry for killing Him.

About two years after I was saved I started experiencing health issues. Each year something else would go wrong and I went from bad to worse. God in the early days gave me a promise that He would heal all of me. He told me, not one thing but everything. This was confirmed by other people. As I write this it is 2018 and I had just had a second surgery for the removal of skin cancer from my lip. I believed that I would get the all clear and have clear margins after the second surgery. Any more cutting would more than likely distort my upper lip too much and I would most likely need plastic surgery and reconstruction. The bad news came that I did not have clear margins. On top of all the other things falling apart on my physical body this news shocked me greatly. I truly believed I would get clear margins. After this news I did not act very righteous or lovely and erupted at God. I told Him I was angry, hurt, disappointed and felt like I wanted to walk away from Him. The loud angry thoughts in my head were screaming ‘I hate you’ over and over but I resisted speaking those words out loud to Him. I told Him the only reason I wouldn't leave was because I believed that the only way to be saved was through Jesus and I didn't want to go to Hell. I let it be known that I didn't like Him very much in that moment. I was so hurt in that moment that I honestly questioned whether I still loved Him. It must have grieved God greatly because I know He saw my heart and the struggle I was having to keep loving Him because I truly believed He had forsaken me.

The next day a friend of mine said that I needed to seek God on how to proceed with everything going on in my life and that I needed His direction. I got overwhelmed with a feeling of unworthiness. I couldn't go to God and ask His guidance on direction. I had just been really horrible to Him, how could I have the cheek to ask for His help. I talked with Mark (my husband) and He said that God would want me to go to Him. I broke down before God and apologised for my behaviour and told

Him that I still loved Him and that I needed His guidance because even though I had not seen His goodness in my circumstances I still believed that His ways were the best ways and I trusted His ways above everything else. I worshipped God and sang my heart out to Him. In that moment I felt His presence and He said ***“You are no longer held accountable for the sin of your ancestors. I forgive you and I set you free.”*** I wept and wept but didn’t actually know what I was set free from.

Two days later I was sitting at my dining room table and I heard the words ***“Seek His heart – He wants to give you your hearts desires”***. I asked aloud – “How do I do that?” He replied – ***“Tell Him that you want to seek His heart and that you want to know all about Him”***.

I already knew that you needed to put aside time to seek the Lord Jesus where it is all about Him with no agendas. I had done this on numerous occasions but I always found that my issues would get in the way. In these special times you need to make a conscious decision that it is not about you and that it is all about getting to know Him. I would start off well, then I would get in the habit of seeking answers or direction during these times because the worries of the world would take me away from just simply getting to know Him. Those times are about changing your mind-sets and focus to be just about Him. I wasn’t very good at that when I was suffering. God had once told me that the ultimate sacrifice was wanting Jesus simply for who He is and not for any other purpose. He wants us to want Him from a completely selfless place.

After hearing those words to ‘Seek His heart’ I went to my room, sat on my bed and told Jesus that I wanted to seek His heart and wanted to know all about Him. He then spoke – ***“There is so much I want to show you. Give Me your heart’s desires and I will give you mine. Keep your eyes fixed on Me – look straight ahead at the author and finisher of your race. Asking questions and seeking answers is fine but there has to be a time where it is all about Me. Why? Laying down your life for My sake. Seek My face. This means you want to know Me intimately. It means you want an actual relationship with Me. It is not about seeking Me for what I can give you, it is about seeking Me to get to know Me. How do you do that? I am knocking at the door of your heart. Will you let Me in? This is the door to your innermost hopes, dreams and desires. You need to be prepared to lay them down. Give Me the desires of your heart and I will give you Mine. It is about exchange. When you are ready to give Me your whole heart I will give you Mine. I will let you see My heart. I will give you My heart. I tested your heart to see if you were ready. It is time to let you into My heart. Before I can give you My hopes, dreams and desires you first have to give Me yours. This means laying them down before Me. Laying them down is when what you want to happen does not and you continue to love, believe in Me and seek Me anyway. It is time to see the heart of God. Faith is an action word. You had faith in Me all this time. You have never seen Me yet you believed in Me and sought Me. Seek and you shall find. You never stopped seeking Me. Remember I told you I wouldn’t heal you until you trusted Me. You trusted in My Son – Jesus Christ. If you have seen the Son you have seen Me. The Son is in Me as I am in Him. You trusted that His work on the cross was truth. You continued to seek Him because you believed in Him. You believed He is who I said He was. Remember I told you that there would be an event and that you***

would have a choice to believe Me or the world? If you chose Me you would have a face to face encounter with Jesus. You believe in the Son with unshakeable faith. This is the event. You believe that only through Him you can be saved. The word says that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and that He and He alone is your Lord and Saviour. You still believe this no matter what the circumstances are showing you. All My Children are tested to see if they truly believe Jesus is the Son of God and that He is their one and only Lord and Saviour. In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls (1 Peter 1:6-9, NKJV). Your ancestors did not believe and were the ones who crucified Jesus on the Cross. Do you remember I laid the burden on you? You have been outworking that sin. They did not believe that Jesus was the ‘Messiah’ and that Jesus is God. They hated Him and murdered Him. Repent means to turn away from and is more than just a confession of sin. Hate is as murder.”

I then realised if the words of hatred toward Him I could hear screaming in my head during that moment of anguish were spoken out loud I would have entered into the same sin that my ancestors did – murdering Jesus. I am so glad I resisted that temptation from the devil. What we say has the power to curse or bless. I then realised that Job’s wife had tempted Job to do the same thing – curse God and die. No doubt the devil was screaming into Job’s head thoughts of hatred toward God too, in the hope that He would repeat them. Thankfully Job resisted too. I then had a vision of a large key and a door. Jesus was giving me a key. This is what He said, **“This is the key to My heart. Time to unlock the door.”** In the spirit I unlocked the door and opened it. Jesus spoke again, **“Before you can enter My heart and see what is inside My heart you must first be tested. When you seek Me for Me that is when you are ready. It is not something you can just outwardly do – you have to be tested to prove it. When God doesn’t give you what you want will you still trust and believe that Jesus is who He says He is? I am testing your faith to see if you truly believe in the existence of the Son of God and what He was called to do. But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation (Romans 10:8-10, NKJV). I am looking for those whose hearts are for Me. I am looking for those who believe in Me no matter what. Everyone wants to see the heart of Jesus. The problem is you are not able to receive My heart until you have surrendered your whole heart to Me. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart (Jeremiah 29:13, NKJV). The hardest part of laying down your whole heart is the surrender of your innermost hopes, dreams and desires. Your hopes, dreams and desires are your will. My hopes, dreams and desires are My will.**

(Interestingly the word will in Greek is **Thelema** and means desire). *You need to exchange your will for the will of God. Your will is what you desire to happen. My will is what I desire to happen. Trials and tribulations are designed to bring you closer to Jesus. It is the testing of your heart that shows God how much you truly believe in His Son. If you confess with your mouth and truly believe in your heart that Jesus is Lord even when you cannot see the evidence, this means you have faith. Without faith it is impossible to please God. The will of God is that you believe in the Son with all your heart and receive everlasting life.” **And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:40, KJV).***

After I received the key and unlocked the door the next day I received gifts and blessing one after another. This had never happened to me like this before and I knew that this was definitely not just a coincidence. I had learned how to unlock the heart of Jesus. I soon learned that the heart of Jesus when you find it is all about you. His heart is completely sold out for you. Within His heart is love and blessing that He is just waiting to bestow upon you.

PUT SOME TIME ASIDE TO SPEND ONE ON ONE WITH THE LORD JESUS AND PRAY:

(PRAYER) – “I now offer this prayer to the Lord Jesus Christ. I desire to seek Your heart. I want to know all about You and see what is in Your heart. I lay down my agendas. I lay down at Your feet my heart including my hopes and dreams. I lay down the desires of my heart which is my will and the expectations of what I would like to happen. I exchange them for Your heart Lord Jesus Christ, which also includes Your desires, hopes, dreams and will of what You would like to happen, Amen.”

***** *(After praying this prayer you may see that Jesus is handing you a key to the door of His heart. If so prophetically unlock the door and thank Him for showing you His heart. Keep putting aside time to spend in His presence and continue asking to see His heart. If you do not see a key after praying this prayer it may be because there is still a further testing of your heart needed or that there may still be parts of your heart that you are holding onto. Keep seeking and telling Jesus that You want to see His heart and that you want to learn all that there is to know about Him).*

Blaming God – Two years ago I had to lay down one on one ministering sessions because I became too unwell. God had given me a promise earlier (and confirmed it through many other people) that He would heal me of every ailment I suffered. Over the last six years as time moved on I began to have more and more things go wrong with my health, with the last three years becoming very hard to live a normal life. During this time when feeling very discouraged and full of doubt and loss of hope the Holy Spirit would always come through and give me a new revelation and reason why I had not yet received my healing. I also got told that I would receive healing and a second infilling of the Holy Spirit into my soul when the Lord had finished showing me all the blockages and unyielded areas in my life that prevented me from receiving all He had for me. These special times of receiving keys and revelations helped immensely to uplift and support me through a very tough time but I had recently come to a place where I said to God ‘No more’. I told Him that although I had loved the revelations and keys I was

feeling so discouraged because although they were all very awesome none of them had yet helped me in my health. I felt as though I was 'all talked out'. I knew that the reason I hadn't received my healing was because of the blockages on my end preventing it, but God had also shown me that His timing was another prevalent factor. If you are one waiting and waiting for the promises of God to come to pass you will understand how hard the waiting can be. With each new revelation I would always hope that this was the last one and that the waiting was over and I would receive His healing but alas it never was. I had literally come to a place where receiving yet another key (with no results) was too much for me. I needed results and needed God to fulfil His promises to me! If you can imagine a donkey chasing a carrot on a piece of string for years and years never being able to reach it, that is how I felt.

Three weeks after telling God this, I was feeling absolutely low and discouraged and I hadn't felt or heard from Him at all in this time. I really needed His encouragement and for Him to give me hope again. Whoops - I had previously told Him I didn't want His keys and revelations anymore (because they felt to me like false hope), but of course were not false hope, and instead were stepping stones to my victory. I realised in that moment that they really were my lifeline, and not only that the lifeline of many others. I did need them and when I wasn't receiving them it felt like all hope had been taken away. I repented and told Him I was sorry and that I really needed to hear His revelations and words of hope again. Another week went by and still nothing when a friend rang to ask me to pray over the phone with her about injustices that had happened to her Grandmother and another friend of hers. The word injustice according to Wikipedia is 'a quality relating to unfairness or undeserved outcomes'. After we prayed we sat and waited on the Holy Spirit and this is what He showed me: - Every action we make has consequences – this can be good or bad. Sometimes bad things happen to us as a consequence of sinful choices in our own lives, or even because of the choices our ancestors have made that have been passed down the generational line. The Bible tells us also that we will suffer affliction as a result of following Jesus. Other times we can be treated unjustly through no fault of our own and in these cases it really isn't fair. He spoke as these revelations were being shown to me, ***“You need to forgive God for the things that aren't fair because He didn't stop them or intervene in anyway.”***

I told my friend what I heard and she said “I don't need to repent of that as I don't blame God for anything. I look only for the blockages and the reasons why I am not receiving.” Her answer surprised me and in that moment I was convicted. I was blaming God for taking so long with my healing. I was disappointed in Him and really quite hurt and very annoyed with Him. I spoke out loud to God and said “Why don't you stop the injustices where things that are not fair then? He replied, ***“Sometimes things have to be worked out. It is in the working out that the revelations, keys and healing can come. I would never withhold healing or blessing without a cause or good reason because I am good!”*** The word blame according to Dictionary.com is 'To hold accountable for, and disapprove because of, some error, mistake'. Merriam Webster says the definition of blame is 'To say or think that a **person** or thing is responsible for something bad that has happened'. I was holding God responsible and in essence claiming He was in error, or making a mistake. God never makes errors, nor does He make mistakes. I repented for blaming God and my friend and I ended our phone call. When I hung up the phone the Holy Spirit continued.

This is what I believe I heard Him say: *If you blame God for your misfortunes you are complaining against Him and the consequences are that you open yourself up to the destroyer. Nor complain, as some of them also complained, and were destroyed by the destroyer (1 Corinthians 10:10, NKJV). Although injustices and bad things may happen and God does not stop them you should never hold Him accountable by blaming Him. Your own healing has been prolonged because you have been complaining against God. Being disappointed in Me is the same as blaming Me. Being disappointed you are not healed is not the same as being disappointed in Me. When you first met Me you witnessed My power and knew I held the power to help you. You believe I have withheld that power from you and cannot understand why you haven't received it for yourself yet. Although I have taught you about the blockages and revealed many things to you, you became impatient. Waiting is hard. I told you My timing was pertinent to your healing. My timing is perfect. You got sick of the waiting. You are human and I understand this, especially when you are suffering. Instead of continuing to trust you entered into blaming and being disappointed in Me. Many of My children have entered into this. It is time for them to repent. It is okay to be sad or disappointed that you haven't received My healing but it is not okay to hold me accountable as this is insinuating I have made a mistake.*" I spoke, "But Lord you have told me in the past that your timing is pertinent to my healing, how do I not blame you when you hold all the control, especially when each day I am suffering?" He spoke, "**Acceptance. What did Job do? He accepted that I was God the Potter and he was the clay. He said 'Who am I to question you'? You are my creation and you have to come to a place where you accept that I am God and that I am in control and that I do things My way and not the way of man. There are things in life that cause hurt, sorrow, grief and pain – but you cannot blame Me. Acceptance – realising I am God and I do not change. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever (Hebrews 13:8, KJV). I do not do things in order to punish or destroy, I do what I do to make things better. Everything I do is for good. My justice system is good. I am fair. Good and upright is the LORD; Therefore He teaches sinners in the way. The humble He guides in justice, And the humble He teaches His way. All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth, To such as keep His covenant and His testimonies. For Your name's sake, O LORD, Pardon my iniquity, for it is great (Psalm 25:8-11, NKJV).**

The LORD is merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy. He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever. He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities (Psalm 103:8-10, NKJV). If things in life are unfair then trust Me to use them and turn them to good. How you view Me is holding you back. Ask Me to show you Me through My eyes rather than how you see Me through your eyes. Things are about to change for you. You will become one of my greatest advocates because I am going to allow you to see Me through My eyes. This will give you wisdom, revelation and understanding into My ways and why I do things the way I do. Your new Ministry is 'seeing through Gods eyes and from Gods perspective'. My ways are not your ways but I want to show you My ways and you will see My ways are good. You will see through the eyes of God and you will think through the mind of Christ. Yes my daughter things are about to change for you."

(PRAYER) – “In Jesus name I repent for how I have handled injustices. I repent for believing I have been dealt with unfairly when it was mine or my ancestor’s choices that meant negative consequences. In doing this I was complaining against Gods law. I am sorry for the blame I put on You for all injustices and negative things that have happened in my life. I repent for being offended at You and for holding unforgiveness toward You. I forgive You for the times You never stopped or intervened in the things that weren’t fair. Blaming You and being disappointed in You is complaining against God and insinuating that You have made an error. You are God and You do not make mistakes and You are never wrong. You are good and You are fair. I ask that You would show me ‘You’ through Your eyes rather than how I see You through my eyes. I speak to the destroyer and command you to leave me, my life and circumstances now in the name and power of Jesus Christ. Thank You Lord Jesus, Amen.”

Contending with God – Shall he that contendeth with the Almighty instruct him? He that reproveth God, let him answer it (Job 40:2, KJV). The word contendeth in Hebrew is **Riyb** and means Plead, strive, contend, chide, debate, misc; 1) to strive, contend, 1a1) to strive 1a1a) physically 1a1b) with words 1a2) to conduct a case or suit (legal), sue 1a3) to make complaint 1a4) to quarrel 1b) (Hiphil) to contend against

We all know the story of Job. God allowed Satan to test Job with afflictions because He knew that Job would not curse Him and walk away. While Job was going through his afflictions he had no understanding of why. He considered himself a righteous man and his friends kept condemning him, coming up with many different reasons why he was being afflicted by God. Job went head to head against God arguing his case against Him. The end of the story is when God shows Job just how mighty He is and that His ways are higher than our ways. This is what God spoke to Job, **“Now prepare yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer Me: “Would you indeed annul My judgment? Would you condemn Me that you may be justified? (Job 40:7-8, NKJV).** Job’s answer to God was this; **Then Job answered the LORD and said: “I know that You can do everything, And that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You. You asked, ‘Who is this who hides counsel without knowledge? ’Therefore I have uttered what I did not understand, Things too wonderful for me, which I did not know. Listen, please, and let me speak; You said, ‘I will question you, and you shall answer Me.’ “I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, But now my eye sees You. Therefore I abhor myself, And repent in dust and ashes.” (Job 42:1-6, NKJV).**

How many times have you corrected God, pleaded with God or contended with Him? Have you ever said ‘It is not fair God’, or ‘Why are you allowing this’, or been angry with Him? My entire PDF’s are full of the times I have done all of these things. Every time I was broken in my heart I made a complaint against God. God was such a patient Father and although many times He rebuked me for it by saying ‘Who are you to question Me’, He always helped me through my hurts by giving me keys and revelations that restored my hope in Him. I understood that it is okay to ask questions about things you have no understanding over, and to seek for keys but sometimes in our hurt we can be throwing out accusations against God and the questioning becomes correction, contending or complaining. There is correct

questioning and incorrect questioning. We as humans need to know our correct place in His Kingdom and learn that we are not equal to God and need to respect His place of authority.

So this brought me to this question ‘Do we suffer any consequences when we contend with God’? I asked God this very question and this is the reply I received; ***“Leviathan is the King over all the children of pride (Job 41:34). Questioning God by bringing accusations against Him or correcting Him is pride. Leviathan is the king of pride. Leviathan becomes your taskmaster because you allow him this honour. You bow down to him when you enter into pride. Children of pride. My children need to learn who I am and that I am above all things. Am I angry when you question Me and My decisions? No, I am a loving Father who listens. I am for you and not against you. I am grieved when you are hurting and believing I have done an injustice toward you. I want to correct your wrong ideas about Me so I show you the truth and give you understanding and will continue to do so – always, but there is a consequence to your actions. Leviathan is the king over you when you enter into covenant with him. Acceptance – Accepting who God is, Accepting God does not change and Accepting that God is for you and not against you will help you when you remember this in times of grief. Pray now and ask Me to remind you of this in times of grief. God is for you and not against you and will turn all things for good. Pray now and ask Me to remind you of this every time you are believing a lie about Me. This will help keep you humble and in doing so will enable you to seek Me for keys and revelations for your freedom rather than contend with me for your freedom. What does it mean that Leviathan is king over you? He can torment you and it will be a battle you will never forget. Time to remove Leviathan out of your life for good. The king of pride is removed through your experiences of humility lest you become like him. Avoidance of him in the first place is key. Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you (James 4:7, NKJV).”***

Recently I had been asking God to show me any keys for the healing of my back as I had been suffering excruciating back pain with no relief for two weeks now. Every time I asked about my back I kept getting a vision of myself carrying my cross and it was a very heavy burden to bear. ***Then Jesus said to His disciples, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me” (Matthew 16:24, NKJV).*** A friend had told me that they had prayed and believed my back pain was spiritual. I had only just days earlier had an amazing face to face encounter with Jesus where I was completely in His presence visually seeing His glory, but strangely my back had gotten even worse since that encounter. As I was now communing with Jesus again I decided to ask again why my back was so sore. This is what I heard, ***“Bending over backwards. People pleasers. Pleasing people should be done with a willing heart because you want to bless them. You are currently doing Ministry from a place of duty rather than from a place of willingness because I asked you to”.*** I replied, “That is correct Lord but the only reason it isn’t willingness from my heart is because I am unwell and it is a burden for me to do this. I am doing this out of obedience rather than willingness.” He replied, ***“It is a burden for you to please Me when you are weak, yes?”*** I replied, “Yes it is but I want to serve You which is why I am doing it.” He replied, ***“For this reason I am well pleased with you. I will take this burden from you.***

Have you heard the terminology, ‘The final straw that broke the camel’s back’? Many in the body of Christ are suffering, especially in their backs. This is from the burden to please Me and is from the heavy load you are carrying. Time to lay down that load and give it to Me. First you enter into My suffering – then into My Glory. But after ye have suffered a while, may the God of all grace, who hath called us into His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, make you perfect, establish, strengthen, settle you (1 Peter 5:10, KJV).

And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together (Romans 8:17, KJV).

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. Now if we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer. Or if we are comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. And our hope for you is steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also you will partake of the consolation (2 Corinthians 1:3-7, NKJV). I did not want to drink the cup of suffering My Father laid upon Me and asked for Him to take it from Me, but nevertheless I chose for His will to be done - just as you did too. The Glory of the Lord is coming. This is what you saw in your encounter with Me – My Glory which is coming to those who are ready. This is My promise to you. The affliction in your back is from Me – time to lighten your load.”

After receiving this word I sat there like a stunned mullet and spoke out the words ‘seriously’ over and over. God had just told me that my excruciating back pain was the load He had put on me and was part of my cup of suffering. It was the last part of the journey as I was carrying my cross and was my share of the suffering before I could partake of the consolation. Trying to get my head around this was difficult. All the pieces in my mind started falling into place – that was why this entire thing with my health had taken so long. I was firstly outworking the sins in my life by repentance and confession and then turning away from them by giving them to Jesus as the Holy Spirit revealed each blockage to me that prevented me from receiving from Him. This became this Ministry. Then there was the outworking of impatience to receive the fruit of the Spirit ‘Patience’, which according to the KJV of the Bible is longsuffering. There was also the testing of my heart to see if I was really a true bride. The difference between a true bride and a false bride is that the true bride remains in Him and loves Him and trusts Him even when they are not actively receiving from Him. Many in the body of Christ enter into covenant with Him to receive from Him. God told me from the beginning when I first met Him that our walk is not just about us. It is about Him, our call and the people He has prepared for us to impact and reach. **And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death (Revelation 12:11, KJV).** We can bring people to Christ through our testimony. If we have nothing to testify about how can we show others the way? God uses our afflictions so the works of Jesus can be made manifest through them. The blind man

whom Jesus healed who was blind since birth was afflicted by God so that the works of Jesus could be glorified in Him. His disciples asked who sinned, was it his sin or his parents sin that made him blind. Jesus said it was neither but instead so the works of God could be made manifest in him. If there is no sin or curse operating the devil has no legal right to afflict you. There are afflictions from the devil through sin in our lives that have to be removed through repentance and the grace of God, and there are other afflictions that God Himself has given us (by using the devil to afflict us) so we can suffer with Christ to be glorified in Him, and these can only be removed in His timing. God himself brought Job to satan's attention – it wasn't the other way around. It was Gods idea, not satans to test him. Satan had been wandering the earth looking for people to afflict. God said to satan 'Have you considered my servant Job'? There was no sin on Jobs behalf for the test because he was a righteous and upright man.

God also sent a messenger of satan to Paul so that He would not become proud. There was no sin on Pauls behalf except that he was given revelations by God which could have tempted him to become proud so God afflicted him (by using the devil) to keep him humble. Jesus Himself was afflicted by God for His glory. ***Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted (Isaiah 53:4, KJV).*** God Himself does afflict us for His good purposes which is His will for us. Other times the devil afflicts us through sin which is not Gods will for us. In these instances He is greatly grieved. God promises He will never give us more than we can handle. The Bible says that God chastises or scourges those whom He loves. ***For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth (Hebrews 12:6, KJV).*** The word chaseneth in Greek is **Paideuo** and means chasten, chastise, learn, teach, instruct. 1) to train children 1a) to be instructed or taught or learn 1b) to cause one to learn 2) to chastise 2a) to chastise or castigate with words, to correct 2a1) of those who are moulding the character of others by reproof and admonition 2b) of God 2b1) **to chasten by the affliction of evils and calamities** 2c) to chastise with blows, to scourge 2c1) of a father punishing his son 2c2) of a judge ordering one to be scourged. Unfortunately this is one thing that many Christians do not want to accept – that some afflictions we suffer are the result of God bringing out His purposes and will for us. His will was for Jesus to die and He suffered greatly. He used the devil to do it but the entire plan was Gods – not the devils. He uses the devil to bring about His purpose. God may even choose to harden the heart of one whom He needs to outwork His glory and purposes, just as He did to Pharaoh when he was contending with Moses.

Therefore He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens (Romans 9:18, NKJV). Through suffering we develop more dependence on God, become more Christ-like, develop a deeper faith, sin less, and end up with a truly awesome testimony of His greatness when we finish the race. I believe that without the true knowledge of God in His entirety we can never come to that place that Job did where we realise we have no place questioning His ways. We have to remember always though his ultimate goal is not our harm, but our greatest good. We also need to always remember He never gives us more than we can handle. If it is too burdensome then it is from the devil and we need to seek Him for the keys.

The work of the cross is about the sacrifice of Jesus for us, but not only this the work of the cross is also about our sacrifice on His behalf, for the sake of His body – the church, other believers whom God has chosen for us to impact. A true disciple is one chosen by God who walks as Jesus walked. Although salvation is a free gift, walking in the anointing and glory is not. The anointing to change the lives of other people costs. What does it cost? A laying down of your life to enter into His. We are all called to be sacrifices. ***I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. (Romans 12:1, NKJV).***

After I received this word I said to God “No one is going to like this stuff. They want to hear about the grace and all the blessings that you have for them. They don’t want to hear that it is a partnership and there is a part that they have to play and that there is a cost. They like to hear of the fluffy stuff. Who wants to hear about the cup of suffering they must drink in order to become a disciple – a true follower of Jesus and the only way to enter into His glory”? They won’t want to hear this stuff. He replied, ***“You are right, they don’t but I am calling you to preach it.”***

(PRAYER) –“Father God I repent for all the times I contended with You. I repent for pride. I repent for every covenant I have made with Leviathan the king of pride. I break those covenants in Jesus name. I pray that every time I am grieved, and believing lies about You that You would remind me that ‘You are for me and not against me’, and that ‘You turn all things to good for those who are called according to Your purpose’. I declare as Job did in **Job 42:1-6** ‘I know that You can do everything, And that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You. I have uttered what I did not understand, Things too wonderful for me, which I did not know. I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, But now my eye sees You. Therefore I abhor myself, And repent in dust and ashes’. Your ways are certainly higher than my ways. I am not called to question or dispute Your ways but instead trust in them. I repent for being a people-pleaser – doing things out of obligation instead of willingness. Thank You Father God for my cup of suffering so I can enter into Your consolation and Glory. I trust You and I release this heavy load to You, in Jesus name I pray, Amen.”

******After I had written this prayer and revelation a friend of mine emailed his experiences with contending with God and what God had taught him. With his permission I have added what he wrote as it was a great addition to this teaching. This is what he wrote: -*

Either God is who He says He is or He is not. Either God is the Spirit of Truth and truly cannot lie or He is not. Either His word is always true or it is not. I had to repent and ask God to forgive me for not believing His promises as that is calling Him a liar. I also made up my mind about God. I intentionally determined in my heart to never get angry at God or blame God when things were not working out as promised. I intentionally remind myself that, hey, we are at war with a real devil who wants us to see God incorrectly. I told God that I never want to be angry with Him again and I never want to blame Him. It was not a promise, but an acknowledgment of my desire to see Him rightly and a request for help. So when it happens now, I am very quick to say, "Lord, I want to blame you for this not going as expected. I am trying not to be upset or angry about this. If something isn't working out, it's not you. It's something

else because I know You are good and Your word is true. I trust You." I sometimes add, "Devil, you cannot move me. I am immovable!" In short, commit to remembering Who God is, and never let the devil get you upset and angry at Him, but instead, keep reaffirming God's goodness and faithfulness. When the devil challenges me, I sometimes even laugh and say something like, "Good try devil! Father God, thank You that YOU are good and Your word is true! I give YOU all the praise and glory due Your name. Amen!" Sometimes I simply remind God of what He said and tell Him I know He's working that out. One thing the Lord impressed on me is we are administrators of Christ's inheritance. It's up to us to administer it and if we don't, we can't blame God or get upset with Him for it. I often declare, "I hereby administrate Christ's inheritance. I release..." and then name whatever I am releasing, healing, finances, etc. Commit to reaffirming Who He is and never being moved off it no matter what. It'll change everything for you.

Walk Through The Door! – I was saved, born-again and filled with the Holy Spirit on January 19th 2009 in a dramatic encounter with Jesus whilst at home on my toilet one morning. Not long after this I experienced manifestations of demonic spirits, some of which were from within my own body. I am so spiritually sensitive I can feel demons, smell demons and hear them speaking to me. I sought many deliverance ministers to get set free from these demons I could feel oppressing me but nothing worked. Each time was the same – I would scream, manifest and be told by the minister I was free, only to go home and see that nothing had changed. I sought God on why I had not been set free. He told me it was because I had areas in my life that hadn't been dealt with and these areas had given the enemy 'free reign' and an open door to afflict me. He told me that He had provided everything I needed to be free but blockages on my end prevented me from receiving all He had done for me. He told me that He would teach me about these areas and that I would be set free and in turn be able to teach others how to be set free too.

The first thing He taught me about was the cross. Jesus has offered His life for our life. All we need to do to enter into His resurrection life is hand over to Him our entire lives. It is a swap. There is an exchange that happens at the cross. ***He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it (Matthew 10:39, NKJV)***. This is harder than we think. There are many areas in our lives that we want to hold on to. Take pride for example, we need to exchange our pride for the humility of Christ. That is incredibly difficult. Man is incredibly prideful in many facets of life. Another example is impatience. One of the fruits of the spirit is patience. Humans are incredibly impatient. We need to walk through some pretty tough trials in order to walk in the patience of Christ. Interestingly the word patience in the KJV is 'longsuffering'. We may cling to these areas and stubbornly refuse God access to them. Most of the time it is unknowingly. Sometimes we may think we are yielding them, but God sees our heart and knows when we are not. This poses a problem! Any area not submitted to God is not brought under the Blood of Christ.

This means it stays in the hands of the devil. Although you are still saved and made right with God through your belief in Jesus to save you, your fleshly carnal areas remain unchanged. All unyielded areas have not passed through the Cross. Christ is the door and is now on the other side of the Cross because He has already been through the cross. To go through the door we have to go through the cross to get to

the door. ***I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture (John 10:9, KJV).***

How do we go through the cross? We pick up our cross and follow Him. ***And he said to them all, if any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it (Luke 9:23-24, KJV).*** We need to allow God to crucify the old man within us and we need to die to our old selves. ***Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin (Romans 6:3-7, KJV).*** Dying to self is part of the sanctification process that we all must go through to become more like Him. After we have died to our old selves we are resurrected in His glory. We go through the cross and out the door. On the other side of the door is our promised land and the pasture that Jesus is referring to in John 10:9.

The Lord has been giving me keys and revelations for the last ten years in order for me to be able to go through the door. Recently a friend of mine sent me an email about a vision that God had given her for me. This is what she was shown: - *I saw a picture of you in a room. You could see clearly out of the windows and the view was clear but I saw you searching around for the door, the way out of the room. Searching for keys. This exit was a struggle for you to find and go through. Keep asking God for the keys to His kingdom on earth, as you have been doing for a long time. The end of the vision was that you found the door and you painted it a bright red, so that it could easily be seen by others behind you to exit and those you will help to become free.*

Another friend only a few days ago said that she saw a door and that I was holding it open for many people to pass through it. She then got the word that I was a door opener. This was all very exciting and confirming to me in lieu of all He had shared with me about going through the door.

Another thing the Lord had impressed upon me, was that my destiny in Him would involve ministering, preaching, teaching and travelling around the world, doing all these things in His name. Although I had this spoken to me many times by different people it was never really a reality for me. We certainly didn't have the finances to be able to do this and I was doing poorly in my health so it seemed to me like it was something in my future and although it was a promise from God it seemed so very far away. I have to admit also, in regard to this I have always been in two minds. I pray and pray for the mighty things of God and for Him to include me in His works as I am super excited about these things, and hunger for them, but I am also a real homebody and don't enjoy leaving my home much and if I was just to continue in the work I am currently doing there is also a part of me that is happy to be keeping it low-key and continue just as I am. The thought of it becoming greater both excited me and terrified me. In other words I wanted it but I also didn't want it!

Recently this all changed for me. My destiny in God just got really real and I had a decision to make. Instead of now seeing the promises of God as a futuristic opportunity it was now becoming a reality and much closer than I anticipated.

This is how I came to this; recently we had a visit from a couple we had only just met. God had given them an opportunity for a great business venture where any financial gain would be used for His Kingdom. He had then brought them into our lives where they approached Mark and asked him if he would like to be a part of this business opportunity, which could in turn bring financial support to ensure the future of our Ministry. In that moment when we were meeting with these people I actually for the first time saw my destiny in God becoming a reality. It scared me and I wasn't sure anymore if this was really what I wanted to do. My destiny in God meant taking me right out of my comfort zone. Was I really up for this? Could I really do what He wanted me to do? After they left I immediately got a vision of two large hands coming out of the doorway from our office. I heard the voice of Jesus speaking out of the door and He said ***"I am waiting for you to go through the door. I am the door and it is time for you to go through the door. The last thing you need to surrender is to be willing to enter your God-given destiny."*** I started to weep. This was now so real to me. Big bold me would pray and pray to God for Him to use me in the greatest way possible, and now He was telling me it was a reality I felt like running away. I knew I had a decision to make. I stood there for ten minutes thinking of all the reasons why I didn't want to go through that door. I finally plucked up the courage and decided there was no way I wanted to miss out on the greatest God opportunity of a lifetime and entered into His arms and went through that door. I wept and wept – there were tears of joy, excitement and apprehension – all at once!

Not long after this the Lord then told me He had a word for me. This is what I heard; ***"You have gone through the door! What does this mean? No more blockages. Nothing unyielded. You have exchanged your life for My life. You have surrendered and laid down all that you hold dear. I am the door and you have now gone through the door. You will teach all that is needed for others to pass through the door. Arms outstretched I am waiting for all to enter. I am on the other side of the cross where your oasis of blessing awaits. All you have to do is enter into My resurrection life. My life for your life. All must pass through the cross. You are crucified with Christ and resurrected into His glory. This is the season of New Beginnings. The outpouring of My Glory is next. All who have been a recipient of your Ministry - past, present and future will partake and enter into the reaping of what you have sown. Sowing and reaping. What you and others have put in to people to further My Kingdom will sprout and grow and yield good fruit. Those who have yielded more will gain more. The anti-Christ has begun to rise and I am raising up a standard against him. So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him (Isaiah 59:19, KJV). The outpouring of the latter rain will reign down on My Children and quench their thirst. For too long they have been crying out. There is coming a great and mighty outpouring of My Holy Spirit. Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain (James 5:7, KJV). My restraining arm over the world will be taken away which***

*gives the enemy full reign but My Holy Spirit will also be unrestrained within those whom I have chosen to carry My glory. He will be in His fullness within them. I am judging the world – he who has no part in the world will not be touched. I am removing the world from you. You are the light of the world and the salt of the earth. These ones will light the way and season that which has lost its flavour. How do you season something that has lost its flavour? You spice it up. In other words those who are lukewarm need to see and hear the word of God in action. **Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man (Colossians 4:6, KJV). This will ignite the fire within them again.***

For every one shall be salted with fire, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt (Mark 9:48, KJV). They have lost their spark. You are a Firestarter among many who have been chosen by God to bring those who have lost their spark back to life. I will open doors for these ones. You will minister, you will preach and you will walk in signs and wonders.

(PRAYER AND PROPHETIC ACT) – Ask Jesus to show you the door. Ask Him to also show you what is still to be surrendered before you can go through the door. Once you see the door and have surrendered it to Jesus and are truly willing to let it go, walk through the door into the outstretched arms of your Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Walk into Your Blessings – Recently I just finished writing an article called ‘Walk Through The Door’ where Jesus had taught me that He was the door, and that He was waiting on the other side of the cross (as He has already been through it) for us to enter. He told me in order for us to go through the door, we first have to go through the cross before we can enter through the door. After we have gone through the door we need to exit and go out and walk into our blessings. ***I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture (John 10:9, KJV).*** The pasture is the oasis of blessing. When we first make Jesus our Lord and Savior there is an exchange made between us and Him and it is all about us laying down our lives for His resurrection life. He also once told me that when we have gone through the cross and entered through the door He takes away our stony hearts and replaces it with a heart of flesh. It is the sanctification process of the inner man. He takes away our carnal heart and replaces it with His heart. In other words, not only are our lives exchanged at the cross, so are our hearts. ***And I will sanctify My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the LORD,” says the Lord GOD, “when I am hallowed in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God (Ezekiel 36:23-28, NKJV).***

A week ago Jesus showed me the door and I wept as I entered in. After this I assumed that the blessings would automatically come to pass. They didn't – in fact my life took a turn for the worst. The day after I had walked through the door I pinched the sciatic nerve in my leg. It got progressively worse over the next few days to the point I couldn't move, walk or even rest without excruciating pain. Five nights of three hour sleeps per night because of the pain I became so run down I then came down with the flu. This was full on flu with body aches, shivering, congestion, chesty cough, night sweats – the works. So now I had the flu and was still in intense pain with my leg. I also suffer from acid reflux and knowing my stomach is sensitive to nurofen which is good for sciatica I had no choice but to take one as the pain in my leg was not being touched by the Panadol. That night (after the nurofen) I had reflux and burning that caused me to gag and choke on acid all night long. I took Mylanta, quickeze, chamomile tea, slippery elm and gaviscon – all to no avail. My esophagus (or diaphragm – I couldn't tell which it was) then went into spasm and I had excruciating chest pain (which felt like a heart attack) for quite some time. All this was on top of my perimenopause symptoms that I had been suffering 24/7 on a daily basis for the last five years. During this intense time I then also started having terrible uterine cramping and very heavy bleeding to add to the mix. I hadn't had anything like this for over six months (after twelve months you are considered post menopause) so I was hoping that with all my past bleeding issues I was done.

This was not the case. The timing of this was not good. What on earth was happening? I went through the door (who is Jesus) and straight after there was an onslaught of attack against me. One of those nights when I was not able to sleep because of the sciatic pain I was crying out to God and asking Him to help me, I got this Scripture: - ***Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27, NKJV)***. I then became enveloped in a supernatural peace. The pain was still the same but it didn't seem to matter as much as the peace was stronger. I heard Him speak to me and He said ***“Walk into My peace”*** and then I fell asleep. This was the only time it happened.

The days following my sleepless nights Mark prayed for me and he got a picture of a cat clinging to a tree. There was someone trying to remove the cat but it was hanging on clawing the tree to pieces. I was obviously the tree and the cat was attacking me refusing to let go. We got nothing else in regard to this until a few days later when the Holy Spirit started revealing to me the reason why I was suffering immense resistance and attack from the enemy. It first began with Him reminding me about Joshua and Caleb. He told me that before they could enter their promised land they first had to evict the giants that were in there by doing battle against them. I remembered I had written an article a couple years ago about 'Entering Your Promised Land' and decided to re-read it. This article was about first binding the strongman before you can plunder his goods. The Lord had explained to me that when we go ahead and don't wait for His timing by first allowing Him to reveal the legal rights the enemy has against us then the plunder will prove fruitless. Remember the sons of Sceva who tried to command demons out of people. The demons ripped their clothes off and allowed them to run naked down the street. They used the name of Jesus but didn't know their authority in Jesus, nor did they have a personal relationship with Jesus.

The Lord showed me that there are two major things we need to defeat the enemy. The first thing is we need to know our authority in Him. ***Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to***

cure diseases (Luke 9:1, KJV). The word authority in Greek is **Exousia** and means right, power, jurisdiction. The power of authority and right. If the things we have entered into in our lives are giving the demons legal right and them the power of authority over us, we can then only walk in as much power and authority as our carnal selves allow. Our unsanctified selves can prevent us walking in the fullness of all that Jesus has given us. Jesus has given us all the power and authority we need but the problem is we may not be able to receive the fullness of it because of blockages, unbelief and unyielded areas in our lives. **And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief (Matthew 13:58, KJV).** The Bible also shows us that there are varying amounts of authority. **And he said to him, 'Well done, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities' (Luke 19:17, NKJV).** If He can trust us with the small things He will give more power and authority over the bigger things. Another way we can learn our authority is to have a personal relationship with the Godhead. Our revelation and understanding of Father, Son and Holy Spirit goes from head knowledge to heart knowledge. We get to know our creator, comforter and personal saviour by spending time with them in their presence and in the word. Where does this shift from head knowledge to heart knowledge come? The shift happens after God tests our heart over a period of time and we die daily to the old man in us. Throughout this process we learn to trust in Jesus and His word more and more. This happens through the Holy Spirit giving us revelation of the heart of Jesus, His word and revelation of Himself. Unfortunately when we are first born again the fullness of the understanding of what we have inherited isn't heart knowledge. This doesn't become heart knowledge until you have allowed God in you to put to death the old ways. Understanding, obedience and revelation come through our suffering. **Who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered (Hebrews 5:7-8, NKJV).**

The second thing we need to do is have our sword ready to do battle. If we forget to bring our sword (which is the word of God) then we do not have a weapon against the enemy. I then understood why I had been experiencing such an onslaught. I had gone through the door and was about to go out the door to enter into the pasture Jesus had for me and I did not have my sword with me. I hate to admit it but I had partially laid down my sword a while ago. I had in the past battled hard with my sword.

I had even written a PDF called 'Transforming Lives through the Sword' and diligently prayed it every day to no avail. To be honest I had given up claiming and declaring the word because it never seemed to work for me. How many times had I done this in the past to no avail or just been attacked more? How could I evict the giants from my land without the word of God. This is what the Lord spoke to me about this: - **The word of God has power. When you use it against the enemy it wounds him. He lashes out in anger. If he has no claim over you he cannot touch you. If he does then he can inflict some serious wounding. Before you plunder a strongman's house you must first bind (tie up) the strong man and then plunder his goods (Matthew 12:29). I have given you all power and authority over the enemy but you gave him power and authority over you with those areas that had not been yielded (given over) to Me. This poses a problem. Should you then not declare the word of God if it just makes the enemy attack back twice as hard? Of course not – always wield your sword as this is good and right, but your own unbelief, mind-sets and unyielded areas can make the word of God of no effect**

in your own life and circumstances. This can cause you to neglect the word of God because it appears that the word of God has no power. If you no longer believe in its power you may stop using it. The word of God is the very key for breaking and dismantling the enemy in your life. I need you to get back into My word. Use it, declare it and watch My anointing flow. Why now? Because I have dismantled the enemies legal rights against you and the word of God is now no longer of 'no effect'. It will carry the power I need it to. I have anointed you. You will carry My great and strong sword as a mighty weapon. My word destroys the power of the enemy. You will walk in My power, carry My power and speak healing power into the lives of many."

I then asked God the best way I could use His sword in order to claim my inheritance and evict the giants from my land. This is what He spoke: - ***"Take up your God-given authority and walk."*** I then saw a vision of Jesus handing me a massive key. I could see in the spirit that my heart had become a door. I picked up the key (*in a prophetic act*) and unlocked the keyhole in the door. I saw the door swing wide open. I then saw Jesus holding a beating heart of flesh before me. He removed the stony heart from my chest and inserted the new heart. He spoke again, ***"Claim by confession all I have done for you. But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation (Romans 10:8-10, KJV). You believe that Jesus has your inheritance and you claim it by faith. This is what you claim. Speak this over yourself day and night until you get breakthrough."***

Below is the prayer He gave me to claim and pray: (*You can ask Him specifically to give you the words you need to claim*).

(PRAYER) – Thank You Jesus that You have gone ahead of me and prepared the way.

Thank You Jesus that by Your stripes I am healed.

Thank You Jesus that by the power of Your Holy Spirit You have given me the keys I needed so I could be set free.

Thank You Jesus that I have been able to bind the strongman so I can plunder his goods. 'Satan you will return back to me all you have stolen but first let it be washed in the pure and perfect blood of Jesus Christ'.

I am sorry Lord God for believing the word of God had no power over my situation. I rebuke that lie and declare in Jesus name that I enter into all the blessings that Jesus the seed of Abraham inherited for me.

Jesus is the word. He sent His word and healed them and delivered them from their destructions. ***He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing (Psalm 107:20-22, KJV).***

I break off the power of the enemy and impart the word of God over my spirit, my soul, my body, my life, my family, our ministry, our circumstances, our business, our belongings, our health, our house and property and all that is within our sphere of influence in Jesus name.

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers (3 John 2, NKJV).

In the power and authority given to me by Jesus these things I pray, Amen.”

After I had written all this He spoke to me and said ***“How do you walk into the promises of God? By faith. For we walk by faith, not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7, NKJV). Faith in what? The Lord Jesus Christ and His word to establish and complete what He began in you!”***

Post Deliverance Infilling Prayer - “I break every curse over my life from pre-conception to the present day in the name of Jesus Christ. I ask Father God that every curse would be replaced with a blessing. In the name of Jesus and by the stripes He bore on His body I pray for healing within every area of my spirit/soul and body. *(Pray specifically for all ailments)*. I command all misalignments to come into divine order in Jesus name. I cast out the spirit of infirmity in Jesus name. I cast out fear, shock and trauma in Jesus name. I command every fibre, every cell and every part of this body to come into divine order. I command all pain to leave in Jesus name. I pray for a creative miracle in all areas where body matter needs to be regenerated. I command all cells, cell structure, DNA, RNA, and all parts of the spirit/soul and body not to remember all traumas in Jesus name. I pray for the fire of God to burn off all remaining remnants and dross in Jesus name. I command every demon who has access to me to leave immediately in Jesus name. With the blood of the lamb I seal all doorways closed to the demonic and declare that demons can only exit and not re-enter. I bind the demonic doorkeepers and terminate their assignment against me in Jesus name. I ask for the Holy Spirit to infill with light all areas that were once dark in Jesus name. I pray for a hedge of protection to be placed around me and for any holes to be repaired in Jesus name. Thank You Father God in Jesus name for delivering me”.
